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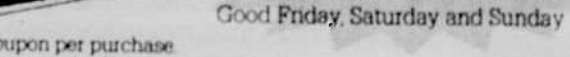

Stryker is a 32-year-old male-to-female transsexual lesbian who has a doctorate in U.S. history from the University of California at Berkeley. She has appeared on Connie Chung's "Eye to Eye" television program and will soon be seen on the daytime talk show "Rolonda."

In her lecture, titled "Rethinking Sex: Situating Transgendered Studies in Contemporary Feminist Inquiry," Stryker talked at length about prominent feminists and sexuality researchers and examined their works. She also talked about her feelings while growing up as a boy.

"I was born with a penis, but I never thought of myself as a male," she said. She did not feel as though she was trapped in the wrong body, but rather that she had no identity at all. "I did not have erotic feelings for other boys, but I did increasingly for other girls."

"Masculinity always seemed like a pose for me," she said. "I followed the accidents of my anatomy. I played football and drove big cars too fast."

She first read about transsexuals and transvestites in a Dear Abby column and searched for more information at the public library.

After 29 years of living as a man, Stryker became a transsexual.

"Changing sex was not something I did for political reasons," she said. "I just could not conceive of myself as a man."

## ASUO president dissolves KWVA board

As of today, the current board of directors for KWVA, the University's alternative radio station, will no longer be operative.

ASUO President Eric Bowen has decided to dissolve the current board, which has been relatively inactive and whose structure does not comply with KWVA policies on record in the ASUO office.

The board has been idle, and one is now needed to hire staff for next year. KWVA General Manager James Pierson, who has been taking on the board's responsibilities, had asked Bowen for assistance.

"Staff management came to

me and wrote me a letter which basically said things are all screwed up — help," Bowen said.

There has been confusion about what the duties of the board are, and that has created conflict between KWVA's staff and the board of directors.

"The board decided they wanted to exercise operative control of the radio station," Pierson said. "Every person in the station was opposed to it."

After Pierson refused to implement rules made by the board that were directed at the actions of specific people, several board members stopped attending meetings.

Bowen hopes that the new board, which the ASUO Execu-

tive is in charge of appointing, will find a way to work cooperatively with the staff.

According to 1991 policies, the board should consist of 11 members. The previous board comprised only five people.

"There has been a lot of turnover and instability in the board because there's only five people," Bowen said.

Once a new board is established, staff positions open for next year can be filled. Training for these positions is supposed to start as soon as possible.

Besides hiring, the board is responsible for writing budgets, being aware of Federal Communication Commission rules and dealing with space requests.
