clean fun. Director John Landis establishes sharp contrasts between the colorful amusement park and the dark-doings of its evil security chief (Timothy Carhart) with energy and enthusiasm. Judge Reinhold also returns as the less-than-willing sidekick for Axel Foley, but his character is once again maintained by Reinhold's quiet, subtle humor. Throughout its 100-plus minutes, the film stays true to form with plenty of shooting and explosions that would please even the most action-hungry audience.

Yet *Beverly Hills Cop III* is actually more disarming and less overdone than the last few 'crowd pleasing' *Lethal Weapon* installments, which reveled in

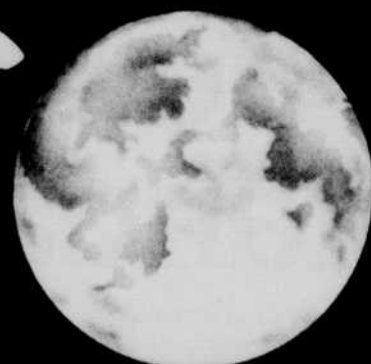
