How can we rekindle and utilize creative energy in the classroom? How can your creative energy motivate creative learning? Art for Teachers is a one week intensive class for teachers to exercise and expand visual awareness and creativity. The focus of this workshop is to provide a positive experience for the participants so that they will feel comfortable and confident enough to return to their classrooms to enjoy these activities with their students, and to continue to create and use more art in their individual classroom situations. Each class will include a short lecture and studio work in a specific medium. All students will participate in drawing, painting, sculpture and printmaking.

Elaina Jamieson has worked as a professional artist/teacher for over 20 years. She has taught in public schools, grades K-12 in Utah and Wisconsin. Elaina taught Drawing for the Fine Arts Department of the University of Oregon as an adjunct professor. She currently teaches Art Education and Visual Arts at Western Oregon State College. Her recent works include drawing, oil and watercolor paintings. Her work will be exhibited during the month of June at W.O.S.C., Rice Auditorium and at the Springfield City Hall.

The fee for this workshop is \$75 on a non-credit basis. One credit in Art Education is available through the Department of Continuing Education for an additional fee of \$42. It requires an additional 12 hours of outside work, including the preparation of one lesson plan and a short presentation to the class featuring the art making activity of the lesson plan. MEMBERSHIP

A Craft Center membership entitles you to use the Craft Center facilities and tools in the Craft Center for the term for which the membership is purchased. Memberships are not refundable. Members are required to have basic skills and knowledge for their given area, assume the risk, and have a willingness and ability to work with others in a safe and cooperative manner. Membership is open to UO students, faculty, staff and UO alumni. In addition, the general public may purchase a Craft Center membership with enrollment in a Craft Center workshop of \$15 or more. Day use passes are available for current UO students, faculty, staff and alumni. Workshops using the Craft Center facilities and equipment require a membership and are indicated in the class listings. Craft Center members receive a reduced rate in workshops where there is the option to take a class with a member or non-member status.

Registration is on a first-come basis, until classes begin or are filled. Early registration is recommended.
