NBA looking for stars in Wednesday's draft

The 1994 NBA Draft, which begins Wednesday in Indianapolis, will mark the beginning of the search for a new star to lead the league past the Bird-Magic-Jordan era.

The odds on favorite to be the new star of the NBA is Purdue junior Glenn Robinson, who has a shot at commanding the first \$100 million contract in sports history.

Robinson, "The Big Dog," is a scoring machine with 30.3 points per game, and has the ability to pound people inside to collect the rebounds: 10.1 per game. Besides being a major force in the middle, the Big Dog can shoot from the outside as well.

It is virtually assured that the Milwaukee Bucks will take him as the No. 1 pick overall in the 1994 draft.

The Dallas Mavericks finished the 1993-94 season with the worst record in the NBA, and have the second pick overall; it is expected they will take Duke senior Grant Hill.

Hill will likely be a great addition to the Mavericks' already improving front court that includes second-year man Jamal Mashburn. Hill's stats are impressive (17.4 points, 6.9 rebounds, 5.2 assists per game), and he has mastered all the skills of the swingman — he shoots, handles, passes, creates and defends.

Earlier in the year it was thought that the Mavericks would take California junior Jason Kidd, but in recent months the NBA has begun to wonder about the people Kidd associates with, who have had run-ins with the law and who may hurt the NBA's image.

By not choosing Kidd, the Mavericks will lose the passing and defensive gifts that Kidd

has. Last year Kidd averaged 16.7 points, 9.1 assists and 3.1 steals per game.

The Detroit Pistons finished their worst season in recent memory and are now looking for a player to fill the shoes of the former star guard Isiah Thomas.

Thomas, one of the few remaining stars from the Bird-Magic era, was forced into retirement during the season due to an injury.

The Pistons, left with their other aging guard Joe Dumars, are expected to take Kidd, hoping that he can start a rebirth of the once dominant team of "Bad Boys."

Robinson, Hill and Kidd are expected to be the sure locks for the first three picks of the draft. It is less certain which teams will pick which players in the next three rounds and the remaining picks.

Minnesota has the fourth pick of the draft and many options.

A possible pick for the Timberwolves is Michigan power forward Juwon Howard. Howard, at 6'9" and 240 lbs., averaged 20.8 points and 8.9 rebounds per game and shot 56 percent from the field last year.

Howard's achievements stretched further last year than just in the regular season. During the NCAA playoffs, Howard averaged 29 points per game.

Another option for Minnesota would be Connecticut junior Donyell Marshall. Marshall is a small forward who averaged 25.1 points, 8.9 rebounds and 3.3 blocks per game.

The Timberwolves have a tough choice ahead, but either player would fit the bill. The hunt is on for the NBA to find the star of the future and it could very well be one of these five players. The draft will be telecast on ESPN at 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday.
