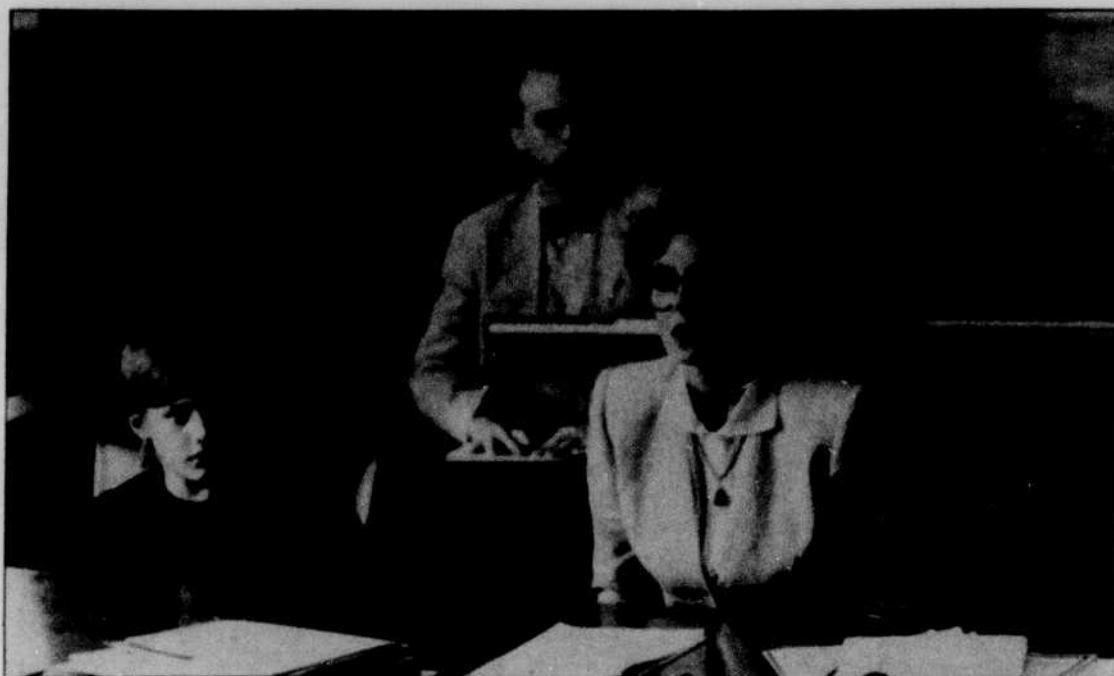

Grisham delivers with 'The Client'

Replete with suspenseful chase scenes, terse courtroom exchanges and even an Elvis sighting, *The Client* is one of the most complete thriller movies of the summer.

The Client is blessed with a quality cast, intriguing character relationships and an interesting story, and easily ranks right up there with *The Firm* and *The Pelican Brief*, the two other movies adapted from best-selling John Grisham novels.

In the film, 11-year-old Mark Sway (played by Brad Renfro) accidentally witnesses the suicide of a mafia lawyer. Before the lawyer kills himself, he discloses where the body of a murdered U.S. Senator is buried.

Naturally that makes the boy a wanted item: He is wanted by the mafia, which wants him to keep his mouth shut, and by the law, which wants to force his mouth open.

Renfro's character spends most of the movie trying to evade these forces, using only his street smarts and the help of his lawyer Reggie Love (Susan Sarandon).

The relationship between Sway and Love is per-

haps the most remarkable feature of the film, setting it apart from earlier Grisham movies and, for that matter, most other thrillers.

Sarandon's skill, demonstrated by Oscar-nominated performances in *Thelma & Louise* and *Lorenzo's Oil*, is complemented nicely by Renfro, an 11-year-old unknown who acts like a pro.

Tommy Lee Jones co-stars as Roy Foltrigg, a U.S. district attorney called "The Reverend" for his tendency to quote Bible verses in court. The vanity of the character shines through (he compliments himself on his appearance more than once), although the screenplay (and perhaps Jones) plays it up a little too much.

Better evidence of Jones' acting talent comes in his exchanges with Love, who makes a formidable legal opponent. Sarandon and Jones (himself an Oscar-winner for last year's *The Fugitive*) give their best performances in battling with each other.

The Client's story is smoothly executed and not quite as confusing as those in other Grisham movies, a credit to the screenplay writers and to director Joel Schumacher.

Grisham's record now stands at an impressive three-for-three.
