The Career Center offers a variety of programs designed to assist students to develop and implement career plans, gain work related experience, seek part-time work while enrolled in school and gain professional employment after graduation. Below is just a sampling of our services:

- 1) Office Orientation & Registration:** Attend an orientation for a comprehensive overview & tour of our services, then register with us. Check the schedule in room 244. This is also the first step to register for the campus interview program.
- 2) Individual Counseling:** Feeling lost in the career search? Need extra help on a resume? Explore these and other individual questions with professional career counselors. Call 346-3235 or stop by the reception area to schedule an appointment.
- 3) Career Assessment Services:** Unsure of your career direction or educational plans? We have solutions!
Career Discovery Program: This one-credit seminar equips you for making decisions through career related inventories and activities. (CPSY 199, 1 credit)
Career Assessment Program: work one-on-one with a career counselor to understand the results of career assessment test you take. Talk to a drop-in counselor to learn how to sign up.
- 4) Success Skills:** A class to identify the skills you use to capture success. 1 credit, CPSY 408.
- 5) Mentor:** Develop a network of professionals in your field for career advice. Call 346-NEWS ext. 3005.
- 6) Workshops & Classes:** Several RESUME, INTERVIEW, JOB SEARCH, and INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES workshops are offered each term. Pick up the current

workshop schedule and sign up in the reception area.

7) Career Library: This specialized library of occupational information, employer directories, career guidance, internship listings, annual reports, and much more is a valuable resource for career exploration and the job search. Check us out in room 247, 346-6006.

8) Career Development Internship Program: Earn upper-division credit and valuable experience in this program, for juniors or seniors in any major. Read about available internships in room 247.

9) Career Center News Line - 346-NEWS: Call the News Line and access the directory of recordings on workshops, recruiting, classes, special events, and more!

10) Employment Services: Full-time, part-time, summer, work study and internship positions are posted in the Employment Services area twelve months of the year, 346-3214.

11) Computerized Career Information: Career decision assistance, job, and internship listings and other career information is provided through computers. Check out room 247C.

12) Placement File Service (for Educators & Graduate Students): Individuals seeking a career in education or applying to graduate or professional school can establish a file containing letters of recommendation, room 247B, 346-6014.
