Ducks' rushing duo topples Bears

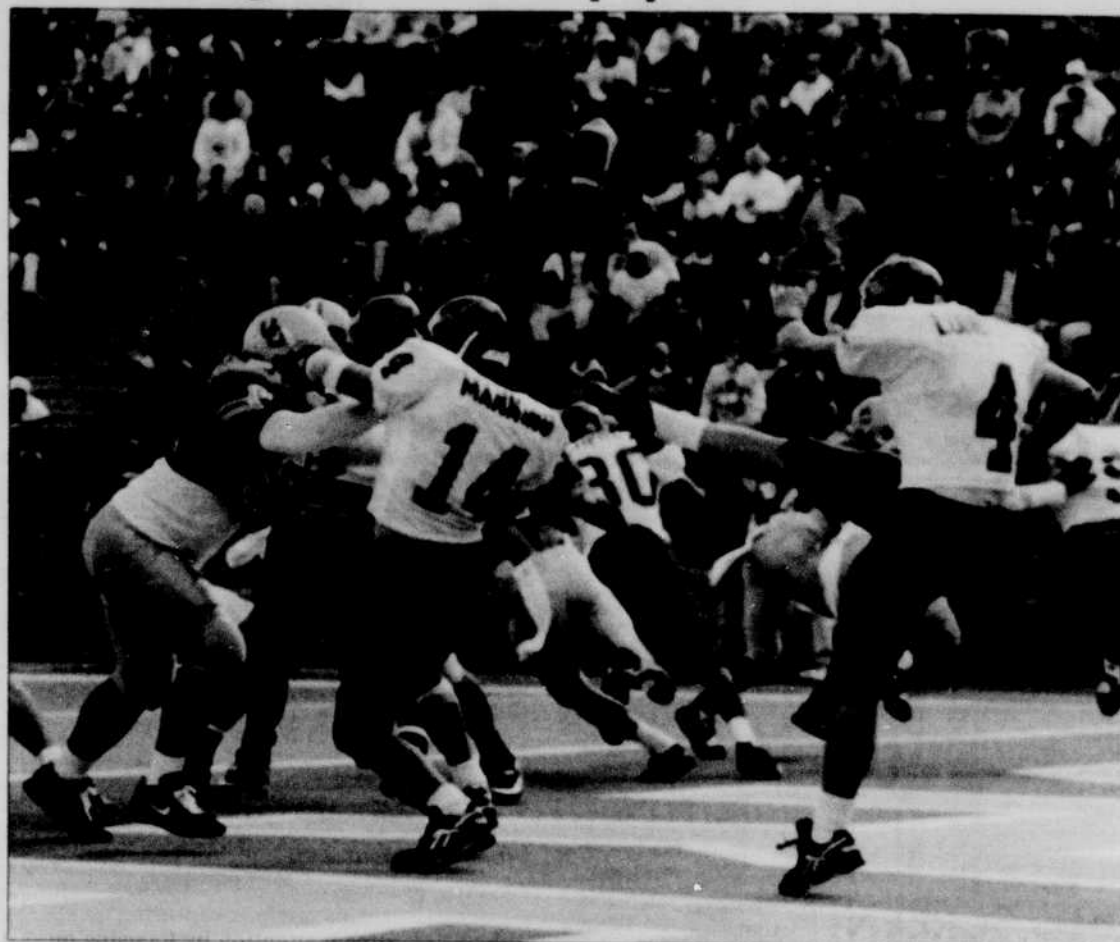

It used to be that the Oregon Ducks relied on a high-octane passing attack and an adequate defense to slip by opponents. But with Saturday's 23-7 victory over the California Golden Bears, the Ducks were able to dominate the line of scrimmage and power past their Pacific-10 counterparts behind the strength of an intense defense and an inspired rushing attack.

Tailbacks Ricky Whittle and Dino Philyaw rushed for 177 and 130 yards, respectively, marking the first time a pair of Ducks have rushed for more than 100 yards in a game since Whittle and Sean Burwell did so against California last year. It also was the first time Oregon ran for more than 300 yards since a 399-yard rushing effort against UNLV in 1992. The Ducks accomplished this feat against a Cal team that came into Saturday's game allowing only 96 yards a game on the ground.

"I didn't really believe we could run it as well as we did," Oregon head coach Rich Brooks said. "I think that the coaches did a very good job of scheming Cal's defense to take advantage of our strengths in the offensive line for the running game."

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California punter Ryan Longwell's kick goes off the back of Tim Manning for a safety after Oregon's Silila Malepeal pushed Manning into the backfield.
