

Justices will listen to cases during visit to the University

The Oregon Supreme Court will hear four cases at the University during a visit tomorrow.

The court visit, an annual event at the University, will be in the Orlando J. Hollis Courtroom on the second floor of the Law Center from 9 to 11:30 a.m. and from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. The event is open to the public.

The justices will hear oral arguments on the cases, Tuesday, and will make rulings on the cases within the next year.

State vs. Matthews, a case that will debate what constitutes probable cause for a police officer to pull over a driver accused of a traffic infraction, will be heard at 9 a.m.

The court will then hear arguments at 10:30 a.m. for Barcik vs. Kubiacyk, a case that discusses the publication of an editorial in a high school newspaper that supported an underground newspaper at Tigard High School. The district administration did not allow the *Hi-Spots* to publish the editorial,

according to the court docket.

Three University students, that were involved in the controversy at Tigard, are among the plaintiffs. Students Matt Lowery and Marco Edwards worked for the Tigard *Hi-Spots*, the high school newspaper, while Josh Olson worked for the *Low-Spots*, the underground newspaper that the *Hi-Spots* supported.

The plaintiffs are seeking to change a policy that the district instituted after the incident, that allow the district to review publications before they are distributed.

In other cases before the court, State vs. Alberto-Mirabal will be heard at 1:30 p.m., and will discuss the rights of the state police to stop passengers of a car and conduct a search following a traffic stop.

At 2:30 p.m., the court will hear Stubbs vs. Weathersby, a case that questions the status of an adoption when the biological mother attempts to revoke her consent to the adoption.

After the justices hear the cases, they will be available to answer questions from the public.
