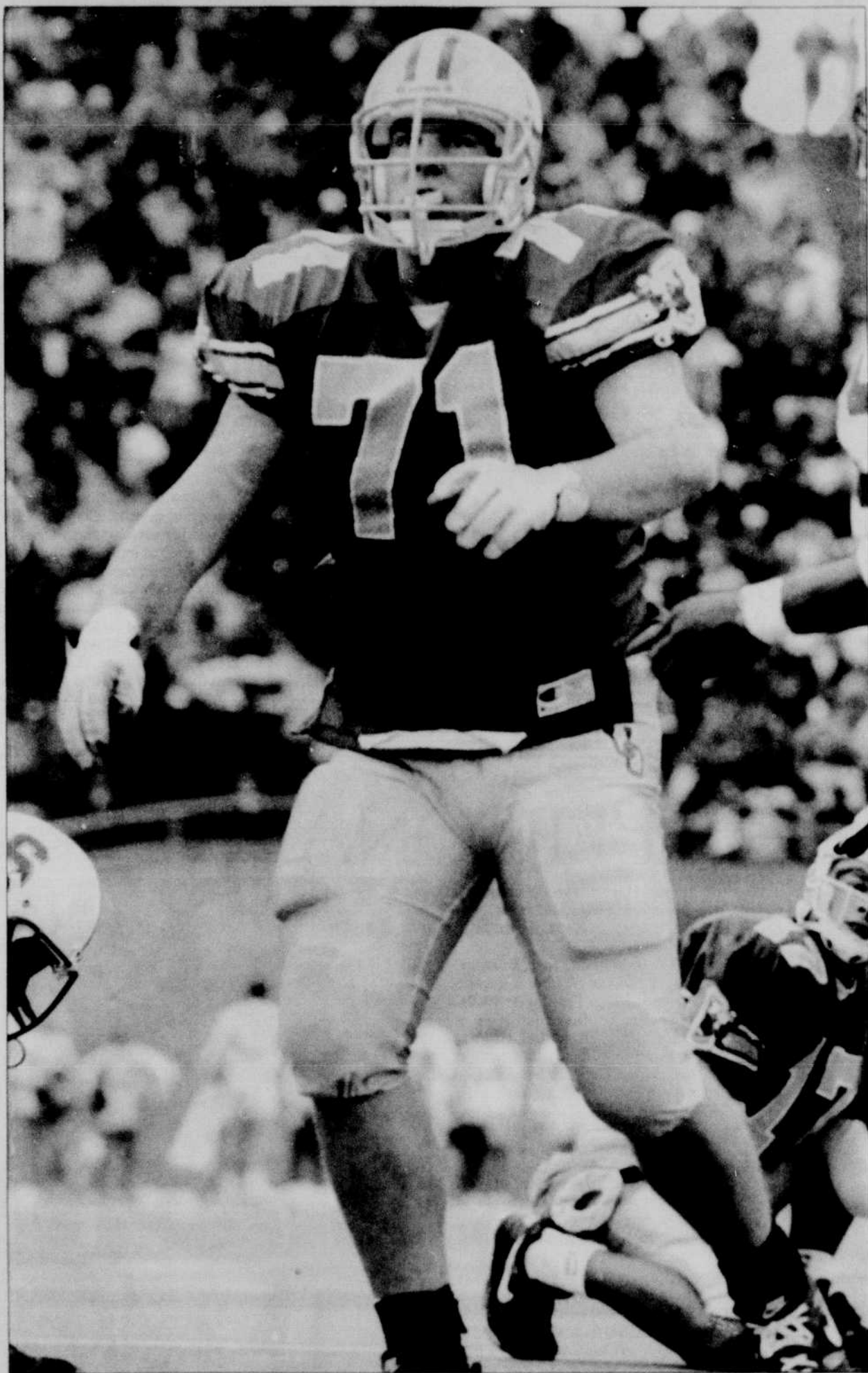

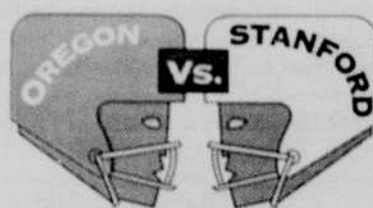


In The Trenches
