

Cota heads football award winners

Senior strong safety Chad Cota was presented the Hoffman Award as the team's most outstanding player Sunday at the University of Oregon football banquet.

Cota's selection in balloting by members of the Ducks' team marked the sixth time in the last eight years that the top award has gone to a representative of the defensive unit.

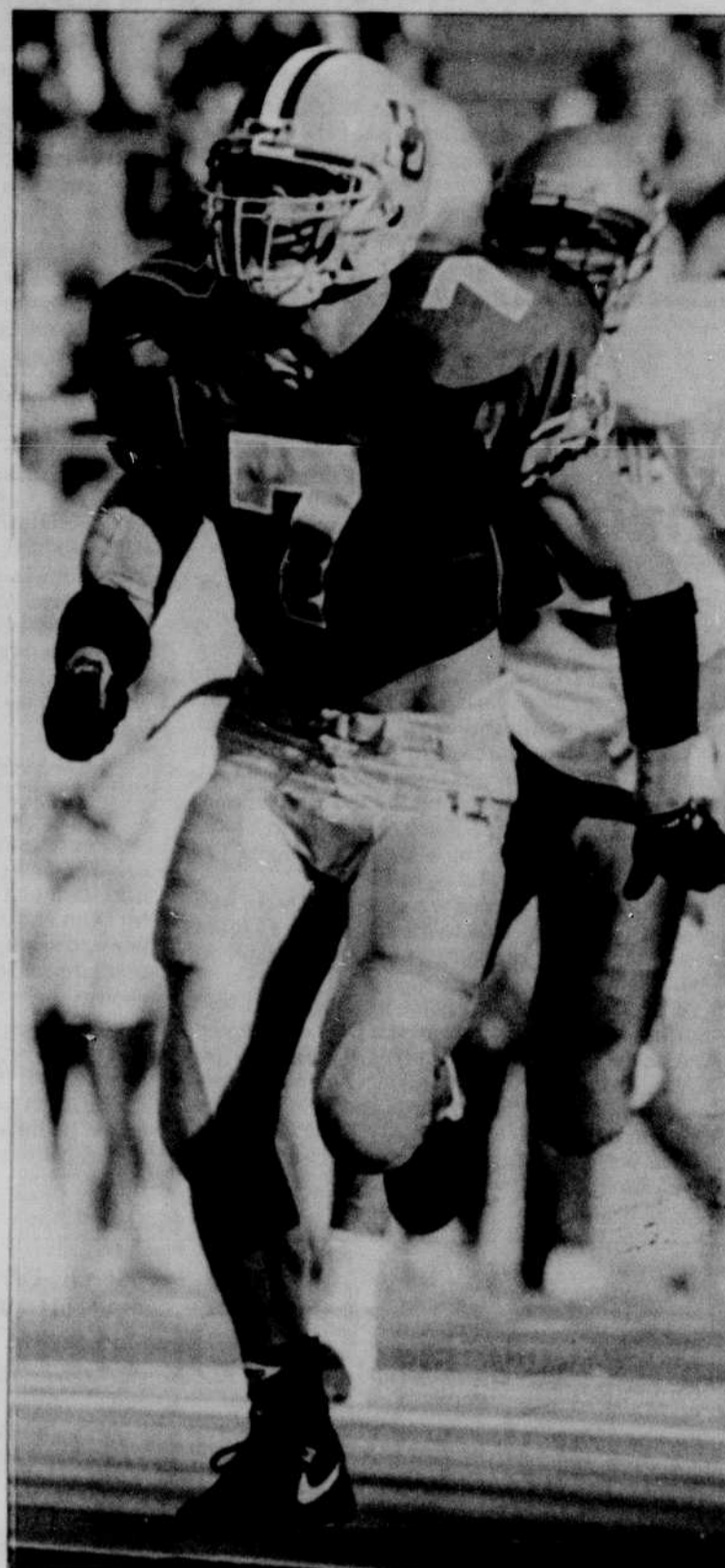
Cota finished the regular season as the squad's third-leading tackler and the Ducks' all-around defender. He also was credited with two interceptions and seven deflected passes. Cota ranks eighth on Oregon's all-time list with 329 tackles and eight career interceptions.

Also among the award winners were senior nose tackle Silila Malepeai, senior tailback Dino Philyaw, senior offensive tackle Steve Hardin, senior free safety Jeff Sherman, senior defensive end Mark Slymen, senior cornerback Herman O'Berry, redshirt freshman cornerback Kenny Wheaton, redshirt freshman strong safety Jaiya Figueras, true freshman kicker Matt Belden and true freshman flanker Pat Johnson.

Malepeai was voted the Wil Gonyea Award as the squad's most inspirational player and Philyaw was selected for the Clarke Award as the team's most improved player. Wheaton and Johnson shared the Len Casanova Award as the top first-year players.

Belden and Figueras were the recipients of the Gordon Award as the top players on special teams and Hardin was presented the Oregon Club of Portland Award in recognition of his play as the team's most valuable offensive lineman.

O'Berry was the winner of the Bob Officer Award to honor a team member who played despite physical adversity. Sherman and Slymen accepted the Elmer Salstrom Award as the squad's top senior student athletes.

But this time, like Oregon State a year ago, the Ducks stepped up and made the crucial plays, even though Oregon's kicking woes continued, with Belden missing two field goal attempts that could have swung the momentum the Ducks way for good. When it came down to it, though, it was Belden who nailed the second quarter field goal, giving the Ducks the ever-so-important advantage

at half-time, and Danny O'Neil orchestrating a crucial final drive that sealed victory. And, while Oregon reversed its overall performance from last year, it was the Beavers who choked at the crucial moments.

Once again, the Beavers running game amazed and baffled the folks from Eugene, and accounted for all but 63 of Oregon State's 284 total net yards. But the Beavers inability to pass proved costly, with two feeble final drive pass attempts coming up empty, icing the Ducks Rose Bowl victory.
