NEW YORK (AP) — In Brazil, where they take their music as seriously as their politics, Marina Lima may not be the reigning queen of pop — but she's got the ambassadorship locked up.

Twelve albums and 16 years after she first began to rock 'n' roll, Lima consistently has elbowed her way into the Brazilian Top 10. In a land of such legends as Gilberto Gil, Caetano Veloso and Marisa Monte, that's no easy task.

But armed with a new record, her second U.S. release, the singer-songwriter known to millions of South Americans simply as Marina is readying for her first North American tour — and a chance to take the world by storm.
