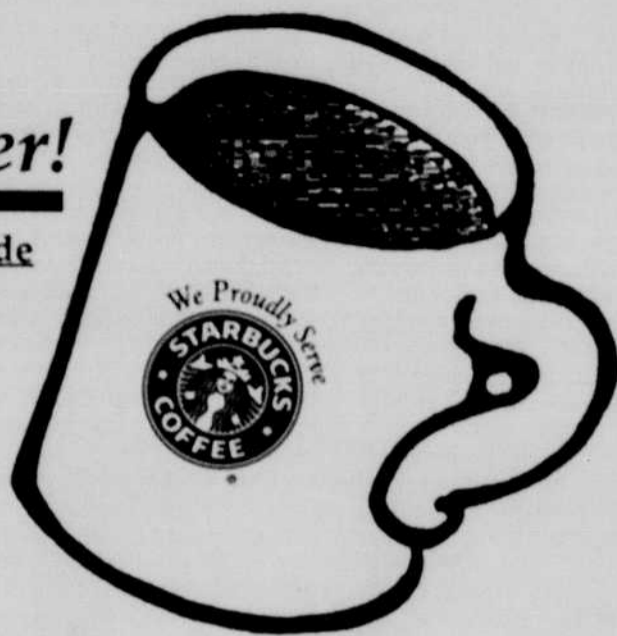

Acclaimed author and poet David Mura will be in Gerlinger Lounge to read from his works, including a newly released collection of poetry, *The Colors of Desire*. A booksigning will follow.

The poetry of David Mura has been praised for its verbal music, its contradictions of rage and reconciliation, and its curious sense of hope in a world riven by racial and cultural differences. In *The Colors of Desire*, Mura explores the connections between race and sexuality, history and identity, through the lens of desire. His books are available for

purchase upstairs at the bookstore and also at the event.
