

Young Mac announces plans to play at UO

EUGENE, Ore. (AP) — Brandon McLemore, younger brother of Oregon's record-setting wide receiver Cristin McLemore, has announced he plans to play football for the Ducks.

The younger McLemore played wide receiver and defensive back for Bishop Montgomery High School in Torrance, Calif. He said Wednesday that the Ducks have given him the option of playing offense or defense.

So far, he's leaning toward defense to avoid comparisons with his brother.

"I haven't made up my mind yet," McLemore said, "but it will probably be defense. I like to hit people and make plays. If I play receiver, there would be comparisons every year on what I've done and what he's done.

"But I might play receiver still. It depends on how I feel, and what I get accomplished in the weight room" between now and August.

The Ducks also received a verbal commitment from 6-foot-5, 240-pound defensive lineman Caleb "Buddy" Smith from Vashon Island High School in Vashon, Wash.

Twenty prep players have made verbal commitments to the Ducks. The first day players can sign letters of intent is Wednesday.

Terreri, Devils nip Bruins 1-0

BOSTON (AP) — Devils goalie Chris Terreri eliminated Boston from the playoffs last year and would have beaten them again Thursday night if it wasn't for Blaine Lacher.

The Bruins rookie made 33 saves and got his third win in as many games when Adam Oates scored with 1:17 left in overtime to give Boston a 1-0 victory over New Jersey.

Oates worked a give-and-go with Ray Bourque at the blue line before putting a shot on net. Cam Neely dug the rebound out from behind the goal and swiped it into the slot for Oates, who put it above Terreri's left shoulder for the win.

"There's really not a lot of time to think, especially when you're on your butt," Neely said. "The puck was just laying there. I just swatted it out to Adam."

Oates called it a broken play and a fluke goal. But he'll take it.

"Cam passed it out when he's not (expected) to. Terreri came out and I just one-timed it," he said. "You always have to be ready. Sometimes you get the bounces."

Lacher earned his first career shutout to keep his and the Bruins' records perfect at 3-0. But for most of the game, he was matched save-for-save by Terreri.

Terreri stopped 36 shots in his first start of the season. Martin Brodeur, the league's top rookie last year, failed to get a victory in New Jersey's first two games.

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
