

Wrestlers lose to Oklahoma, Stanford on road

STANFORD, Calif. — Oregon came away from its brief two meet road trip winless as the Ducks fell to Stanford 21-15 Sunday.

"It wasn't a very happy camp after the meet, that is for sure," Oregon coach Ron Finley said. "We just didn't get the job done."

The Ducks got off to a sizzling start as Kevin Roberts and Jeremy Ensrud both scored major decision victories. Roberts dominated the Cardinal's Brian McBeth 19-6 in the 118-pound match to open the meet. Ensrud followed with an 8-0 blanking of Stanford's Matt Cano and the Ducks looked as if they were on their way.

Stanford rallied, however, winning six of the next eight matches en route to the win. The turning point came at the 167-pound match, when Oregon's Tom Glenn got pinned by Stanford's Matt von der Ahe just 1:14 into the match. Glenn attempted a take down but got caught in a cradle and never recovered.

The fall gave Stanford six points and allowed the Cardinal to take a lead it would never relinquish. The Ducks again could not win at the higher weights, with the exception of heavyweight Nathan Sullivan's 15-6 win over Stanford's Mark Negley.

"That fall really hurt us," Finley said. "But you can't do it (win the meet) if you don't win more matches than we did."

On Friday night, the Ducks got wins from 118-pound Kevin Roberts, 142-pound Cory Sonnen, and 158-pound Scott Norton, but 12th-ranked Oklahoma dominated the rest of the meet, including a one point win over Oregon's Jeremy Ensrud in the 126-pound match-up.

The road trip dropped the team's record to 3-6 overall, and 2-3 in the Pacific 10 Conference. The team heads to Corvallis on Friday for their second Civil War meeting of the season.

And with the win, Arizona State salvaged a split in the Beaver State and are one of the three teams, along with Oregon, tied for fourth place at 4-3 in the conference, just a game and a half behind UCLA.

"I'm proud of my guys," Frieder said.

The Sun Devils return to Arizona with the luxury of six home games in their next eight contests, while the Ducks hit the road for a pair of tough ones against California and Stanford.
