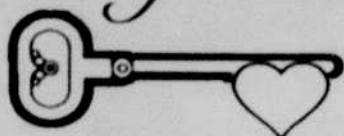
with America. This made-for-Hallmark holiday for some reason inspires an annual onslaught of cheese and unnecessary public affection.

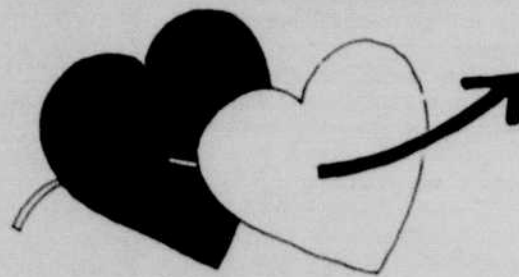
