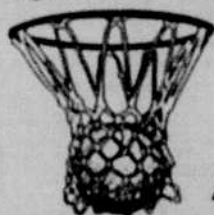

Steel Pulse, long-time British reggae greats, will charge the crowd with positive vibes weaved throughout their new conscious tunes Monday night in the EMU Ballroom.

The band, which has been around for about 20 years, will showcase their new release, Vex, a mix of powerful rhythms and conscious lyrics. With this new cut, the band continues to educate audiences on the evils of social injustice, and at the

same time, instills happiness and healing dance rhythms for the people.

After a powerful and creative start in England almost 20 years ago, the band changed its focus in an attempt to attract more fans. The result was a disappointing change in lyrics that no longer seemed true to the objectives of real roots music - to educate the people on the struggles of injustices and fighting for one's rights.

In recent years, members of Steel Pulse have again found

their roots - and Vex proves the return to their musically and politically charged past.

New lead vocalist David Hinds will groove the crowd, along with the fiery guitar and regal horns crowds have come to expect.

Steel Pulse will play Monday, Feb. 27 at the EMU Ballroom at 8 p.m. Tickets for students are \$12, and \$15 for the general public. They are available at The EMU Main Desk, Face the Music, House of Records, Record Garden and CD World.
