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"Tonight was such a team victory," senior forward Jeff Potter said following Saturday's game. "Right now we're playing so well as a team, and it's exciting to just be a part of this. This was probably the biggest win of our year because the pressure was on us, and we came through."

Oregon's "whatever it takes" motto proved to be too much for Stanford as the Ducks roared to a 44-33 halftime lead, thanks to a 14-0 run after trailing 28-26. Oregon scored the first seven points of the second half to take its biggest lead at 51-33.

But the Ducks' difficulty in maintaining a lead all season came back to haunt them as Stanford was able to cut the margin to five points with 1:36 left in the game. Oregon was only allowed trips to the free-throw line for the remainder of the contest as the Cardinal relied on the hope that the Ducks would falter from the charity stripe.
