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fourth-best scorer (8.3) while ranking among the league leaders in blocked shots (22).

Senior co-captain Jeff Potter won the Harry Ritchie Scholar-Athlete Award for combining academics and athletics for the second straight time. The red-headed forward was the backbone of the Ducks, finishing third in scoring (10.5) and rebounding (4.9).

Providing ample evidence that there is an academic factor in the term student-athlete, senior guard Jon Mitchell picked up yet another academic award for the squad's top grade-point average with a 3.79.

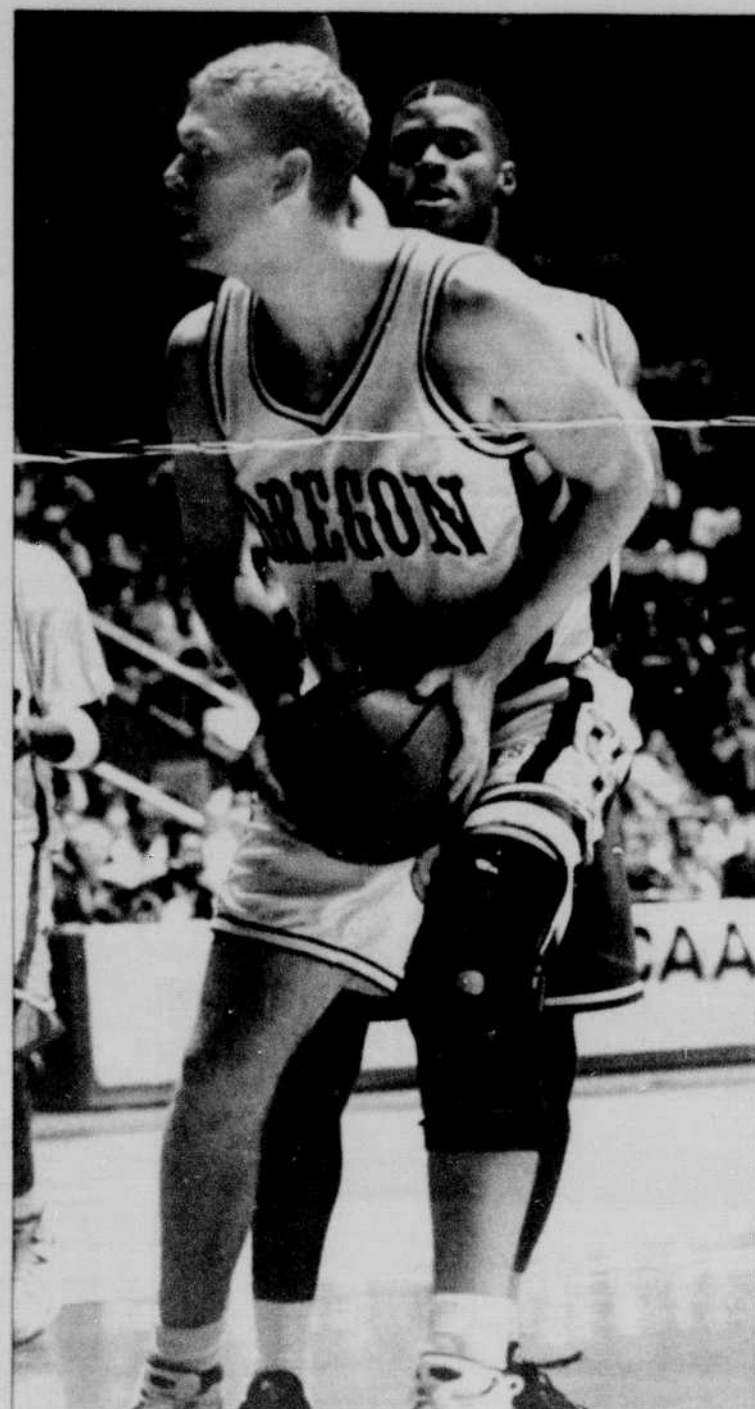
New awards were given to the top defensive player, senior forward Darryl Parker; the leader in assists, sophomore guard Kenya Wilkins; and to the top rebounder, senior center Zach Sellers.

Parker earned 20 starting nods and paced the team in steals with 49 while chipping in 7.8 points and 3.5 rebounds. He finished his two-year career at Oregon ranked eighth on the all-time steals chart with 73.

Wilkins' 171 assists ranked among the league leaders and now ranks third on Oregon's all-time list with 313, just two from second place. He added 12 points, second-highest on the team, and contributed 46 steals.

Sellers, a 6-foot-8 native of Michigan City, Ind., paced the club in rebounds with 5.6 per game while adding 5.3 points per game.

Wilkins was joined by senior forward Jordy Lyden as the team's two endowed scholarship recipients. Lyden's coming from the Robert Steinberg family and Wilkins' by Skeet Manerud.
