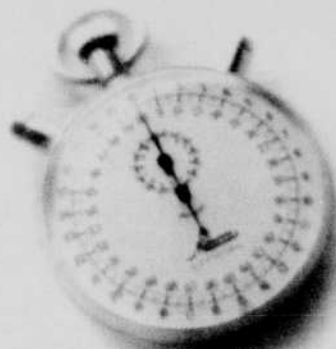




Jackie Joyner-Kersey, age 15
