

Legal adviser to speak Sunday

A legal adviser for President Clinton will speak at the University law school's commencement this Sunday at 11:00 a.m. in the Hult Center for the Performing Arts' Silva Concert Hall.

The 109th School of Law commencement will honor 130 graduates and is open to the public. A reception at the University Law Center, 1101 Kincaid St., will follow the ceremony.

Walter Dellinger, assistant attorney general of the United

States for the Office of Legal Counsel, is the main speaker. Dellinger provides legal advice to President Clinton. He was appointed to the Justice Department by Clinton when he took office in 1993.

It is a prestigious position, said law professor Garrett Epps, a friend of Dellinger. U.S. Supreme Court justices William H. Rehnquist and Antonin Scalia have held the position in the past.

Dellinger's speech will cover the differences law can make in the lives of ordinary people, religion in schools and racial deseg-

regation in the South, Epps said. Dellinger will base his speech on personal experiences, including memories of his childhood in the deep South, Epps said.

Dellinger had planned to teach at the law school during fall term of 1994, but had to cancel at the last minute because President Clinton needed his advice concerning military assistance to Haiti, Epps said.

The law school's Student Bar Association President Katrina Brown and Jeffry Cutler, another student chosen by his graduating class, will also speak at the ceremony.

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
