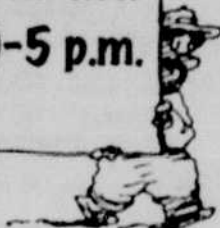


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Campus hosts Harvest Crusade

Former University student Jarl Berg and his friends, literally, went above and beyond the call of duty when they hung one of hundreds of Harvest Crusade posters throughout the campus area.

Boosting each other up to the climbing hooks which run the length of 30 foot high light poles, Berg and a buddy would scale about a third of the way up and fasten posters to one side of the fixture.

"You know, you climb trees when you're a kid. You climb a light post when you get older," Berg said.

But Berg wasn't finished yet. To make sure everyone knew that the Harvest Crusade was happening May 19-21 at McArthur Court, he plastered three bumper stickers across the handlebars and frame of his light blue Bianchi mountain bike.

"Our biggest thing is not to scare off people," he said. "We want people to know about what we're all about, and they can take it or leave it."

Harvest Crusades are defined as public, evangelistic events where the message of Jesus Christ is presented in a non-religious setting through contemporary music and simple yet relevant messages by Pastor Greg Laurie, according to a program pamphlet.

The Harvest Crusade, founded five years ago by southern California pastor Laurie, makes its first appearance in Oregon at the invitation of approximately 90 Eugene-Springfield churches from different denominations.

Organizers expect 8,000-10,000 people to gather in Mac Court for the three-day event. Last summer, a Harvest Crusade in southern California drew 50,000-60,000 people to Anaheim Stadium. Admission is free and gates open at 6:30 p.m. The three day event starts each night at 7:30 p.m. and lasts until 9:00 p.m.

Berg said he and the organizers want to make sure the Harvest Crusade is well-publicized. In the past three weeks, a small army of 150 volunteers have saturated the University area and its students with 9,000 pamphlets and hundreds of posters, which have been tacked anywhere from local business windows to the back of bathroom stalls.

Danny O'Neil, former quarterback of the football team and a devout Christian, said he believes the massive campaign to "get the word out" about the Harvest Crusade may inspire students to ask themselves some potentially life-changing questions.

"I'd say two things: first of all, when people see posters and pamphlets everywhere, people have to ask themselves, 'What is motivating these people? What makes them so excited about what they're doing?'" O'Neil said. "The Harvest Crusade doesn't push it's own agenda. The plan was to reach out and personally invite people."

O'Neil has been working to get a Harvest Crusade in Eugene since he began taking his faith seriously about three years ago, and he also spoke at the Harvest Crusade in Anaheim Stadium last summer.

Although he did not become a Christian at that moment, the experience was still incredible, he said.

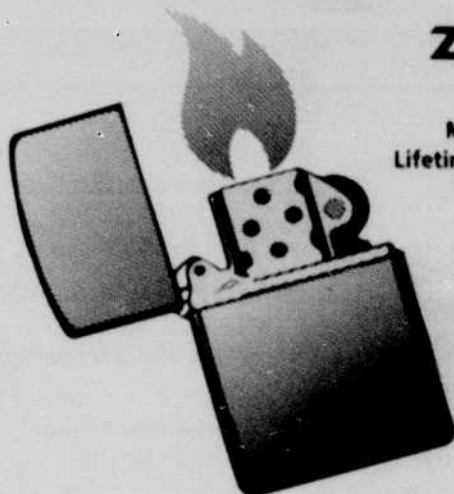
"Greg Laurie had such a huge impact on my life. Listening to his teaching tapes is how I saw Jesus Christ in my life," O'Neil said.

The audiences have steadily grown, since Laurie began the first Harvest Crusade in southern California. The Harvest Crusade travels nationwide and makes stops at different cities to spread its message.

"The churches have to invite the crusade," O'Neil said. "They don't get in big trucks, travel the country and push their agenda. They are invited by the community, and that's amazing to me."
