## All in the family for Seattle draftee

SEATTLE (AP) — If the Seattle Mariners made the right choice, there's going to be another Jose Cruz in the major leagues soon.

The Mariners, picking third in Thursday's baseball draft, selected Jose Cruz Jr., a 21-year-old center fielder from Rice and son of former major league star Jose Cruz.

Cruz Jr., a switch-hitter, did not miss an inning in his three seasons at Rice. He holds 15 school records, including career marks for average (.375), home runs (43), RBIs (203) and slugging percentage (.674). His slug-

ging percentage also is a Southwest Conference record.

In 1995, he hit .377 (84 for 223) with 16 homers and 76 RBIs in 223 at-bats for the Owls.

The Mariners believe Cruz Jr. is a can't-miss prospect. And they need outfield help, too.

"Jose will be a premium offensive player," said Roger Jongewaard, vice president of scouting and player development.

"We looked at our system and we saw we didn't have a lot of outfielders who have all the tools — guys who have power,

can run and play center field," general manager Woody Woodward said.

Cruz Jr. has the right blood lines.

His father spent 19 seasons in the majors with St. Louis (1970-74), Houston (1975-87) and the New York Yankees (1988). In 2,353 major-league games, Jose Cruz hit .284 with 164 home runs, 1,077 RBIs and 317 stolen bases.

Cruz Jr. has two uncles who played in the big leagues. Hector Cruz (1973, 75-82) and Tommy Cruz (1973 and 1977).

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
