

Iron Mike looks to future, settles suit out of court

INDIANAPOLIS (AP) — Mike Tyson has settled the civil suit filed against him by the beauty contestant he was convicted of raping four years ago, the boxer's lawyer said Wednesday.

"All I can tell you is that the matter has been resolved and Mike is looking to the future and not to the past, and that's why he resolved this," attorney Nathan Dershowitz said from his office in New York.

Dershowitz would not say how much money — if any — the settlement involves.

Tyson was convicted in 1992 of raping Desiree Washington in a hotel room while both were in the city for Indiana Black Expo, a black cultural festival. He was released March 25 after serving three years of a six-year term at the Indiana Youth Center.

Washington filed the civil suit against the former heavyweight champion in federal court in June 1992, seeking unspecified damages for assault, battery, false imprisonment and emotional distress.

Trial had been scheduled for

July 24 in Indianapolis before Judge Larry J. McKinney in U.S. District Court.

The agreement has not been filed with the court and the case remains on his docket, McKinney said. Dershowitz, younger brother of Tyson's appeals attorney Alan Dershowitz, said such a filing was only a formality and there is no danger the agreement will fall through.

Washington's attorney, Michael Weisman, was not available for comment Wednesday. He earlier told the New

York Post that the settlement was reached "very recently."

"The story here is about the loss of privacy a woman raped by a public person suffers," Weisman said. "She's made a decision to move on with her life."

Tyson, scheduled to resume boxing Aug. 19 against Peter McNeeley in Las Vegas, has maintained his innocence and pursued appeals through the state and federal courts.

The boxer's lawyers last argued his case in January

before the 7th Circuit Court of Appeals, saying he was improperly convicted of rape when the trial judge selected by the prosecution barred three key witnesses. They contend that it was unfair for the state to have the right to name the judge in a criminal trial.

The appeals court rejected the claim, and Tyson has petitioned the Supreme Court to hear the case.

"He still maintains that the system that convicted him is unfair," Dershowitz said.



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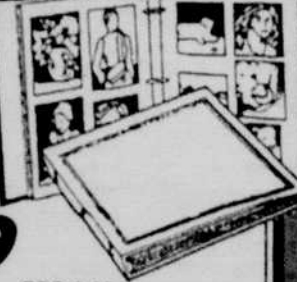


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
