tors' rhythm section. Markstrom keeps everyone on their toes and hopping with his energetic drum fills and beats. He also contributes his vocal talents to the CD.

Smith adds a great balance to the section with his steady bass runs and moving slaps to his sound. Russell rounds out the musical feel, applying his excellent ability to play the keys with a seasoned touch to bring harmony to the listener's ears.

Each musician spotlights his playing style and sound in solos that appear throughout the entire CD, such as Peterson on "Preach the Blues" or Russell and Swan on "Revelator Stomp."

They shine in their solos, but in combined efforts, these blues men know how to blend a great mix.

Each man who takes vocals, Peterson, Markstrom and Swan, has the voice for blues. The range and emotional feeling varies from one to the next, but they can all sing the blues with a spark.

So check out the Revelators on Friday night at 9:45 at Good Times Cafe & Bar, 375 E. 7th Ave.; admission will be \$4. Help them toast to their debut recording, *Preach the Blues*.

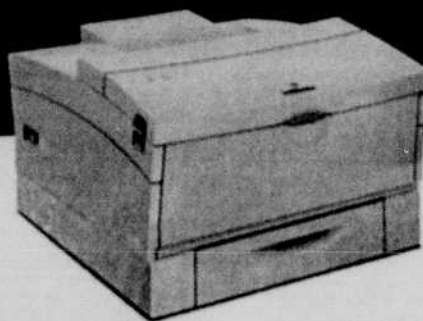
