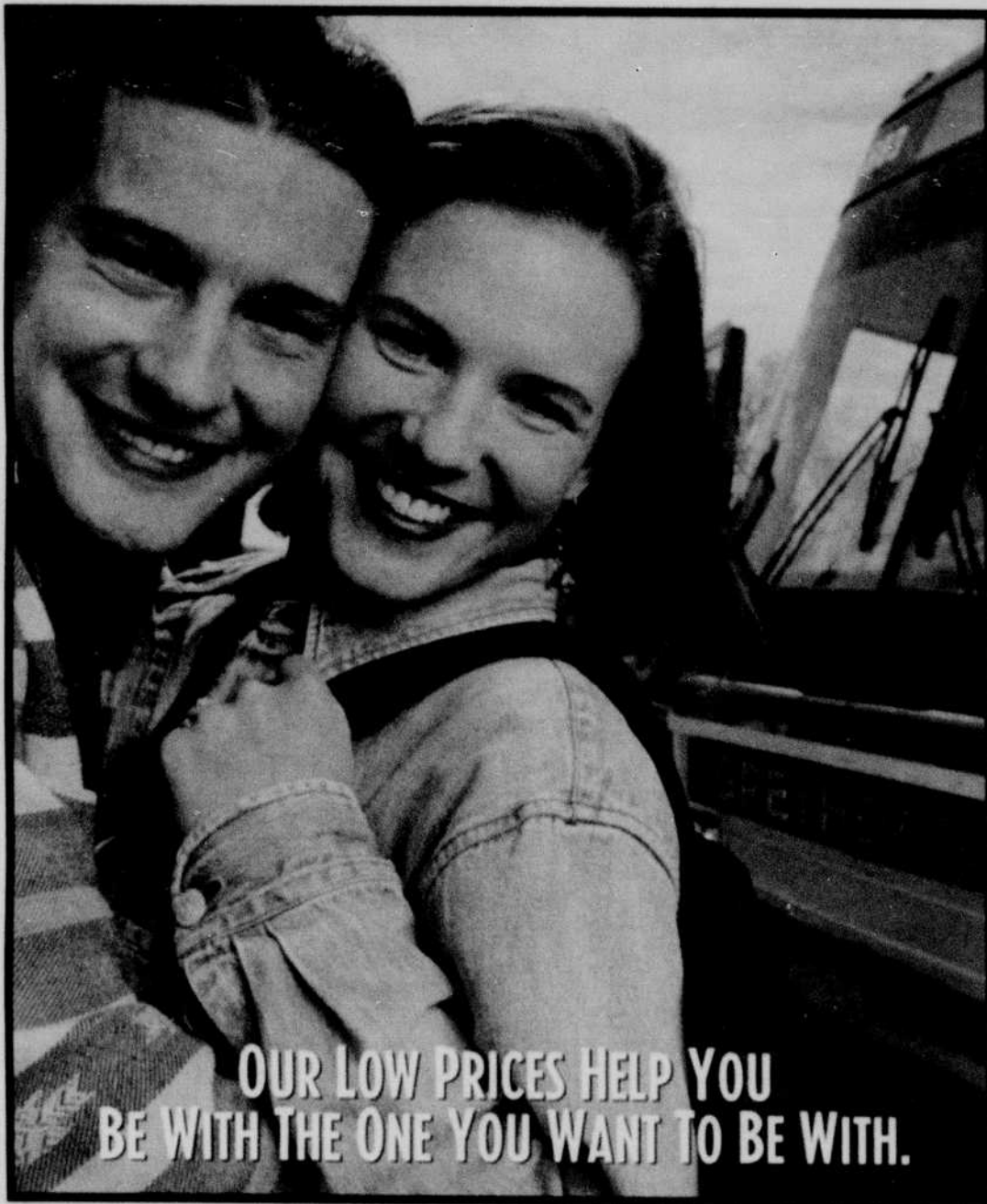

## RECYCLING

piles will be picked up or delivered to whatever company recycles that type of material.

The University saved four buildings for reuse, which were moved to another location for a St. Vincent de Paul low-income housing project. The University intends to donate additional buildings for low-income housing use in the project's second phase, scheduled to begin in the spring of 1996.

University Housing salvaged all reusable appliances, toilets, sinks and fixtures as well as some doors and windows.

Refrigerators and stoves were either relocated into other apartments throughout the University housing system, or donated to local charities.

Salvageable hot water heaters were removed and stored for future use. Smoke detectors also were recycled.

Painted wood and other non-recyclable materials from the project will be made into chips and used as a landfill cover.

Trees and plants able to survive transplanting were moved to other locations on-site and those that could not be saved were chipped and sold for use in making paper pulp.

Staton Construction is pulling all metals from the demolition project, including damaged appliances.

After the demolition project is completed, the contractor will submit a report on the project's recycling activities including the amount of materials recovered.
