program has to offer," Pitts said.

Another electronic option for students applying to the University will be to use a computer floppy diskette. Students interested in receiving more information about the school can request a diskette that is DOS, Windows or Macintosh compatible.

The diskette will have an application on it that students can fill out and mail back to the Office of Admissions. By eliminating some of the paperwork, the diskette is expected to make the application processing job much easier for the admissions office.

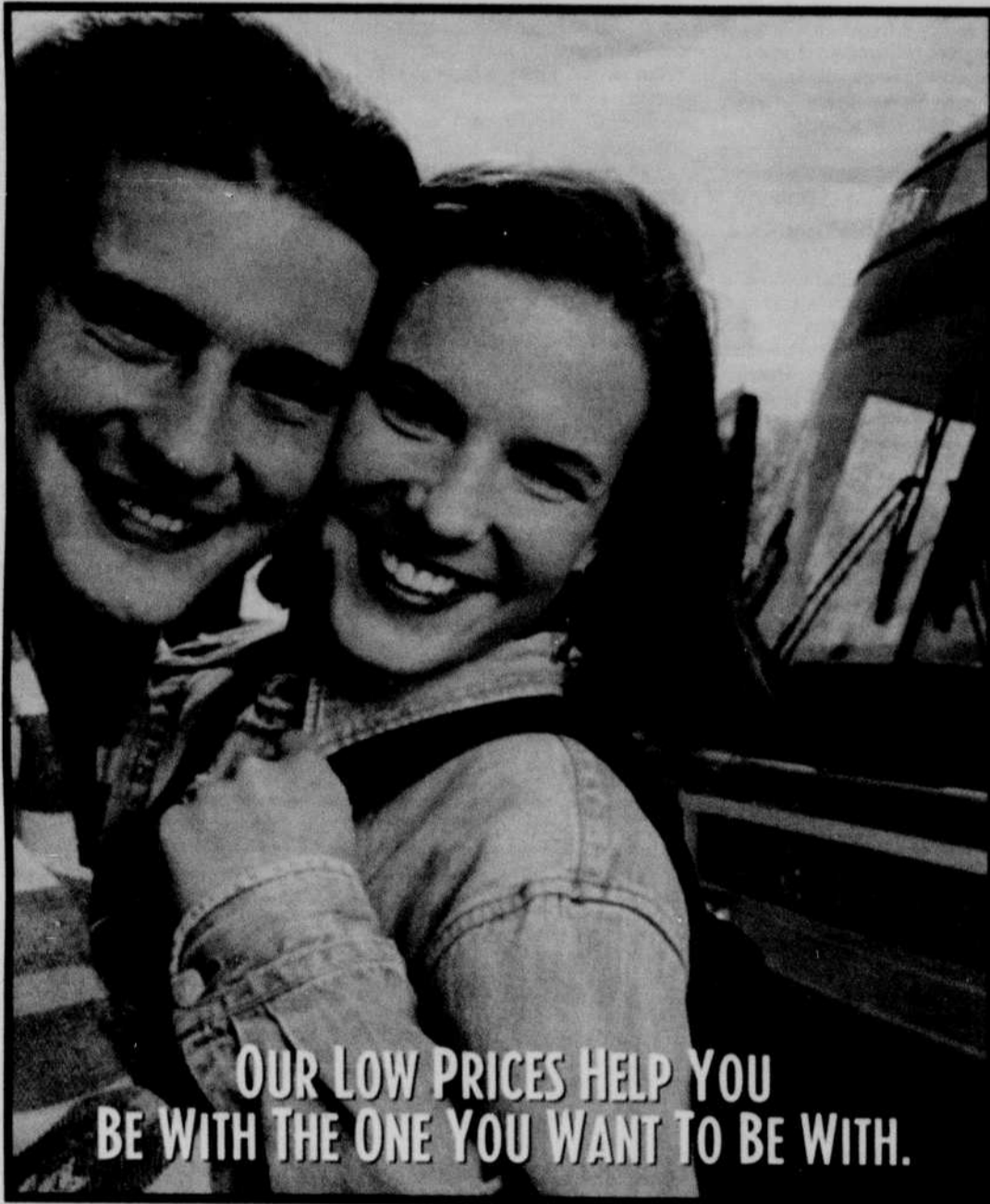
Admissions officials say that the diskette and on-line application should both be available by the end of fall term 1995.
