Voodoo Glow Skulls combine punk and ska

■ **HARDCORE:** Band's abundant energy returns to Eugene's WOW Hall on Wednesday night

The Voodoo Glow Skulls will hit the WOW Hall Wednesday with music that combines an aggressive punk sound with frantic ska.

The band, out of Riverside, Calif., was picked up by Epitaph records and plans an October release date for its latest album, *Firme*, which includes the songs "Drunk Tank," "Charlie Brown" and "Fat Randy."

Joe McNally plays the trumpet, Joey Hernandez plays the saxophone, Frank Casillas does vocals, Jerry O'Neill plays drums, Brody Johnson plays bone, Eddie Casillas plays guitar and Jorge Casillas plays bass

for the Skulls.

In a recent *Rolling Stone* interview, Frank Casillas said the band's "trademark blast of horn and shouted lyrics is what identifies them as Riverside's finest."

These qualities prompted Epitaph owner Brett Gurewitz to sign on the Skulls as soon as they became available. Gurewitz said the frenetic grooves and hyperactive rhythms permeate the band's early releases.

The Skulls tour feverishly and spend little time at home. When they are in Riverside, however, look for them at Cheap Guy Music, the band's own independent punk rock record store.

The WOW Hall opens at 8:30 p.m. and the show begins at 9. Tickets are \$6 in advance and \$7 at the door. For more information, call 687-2746.


