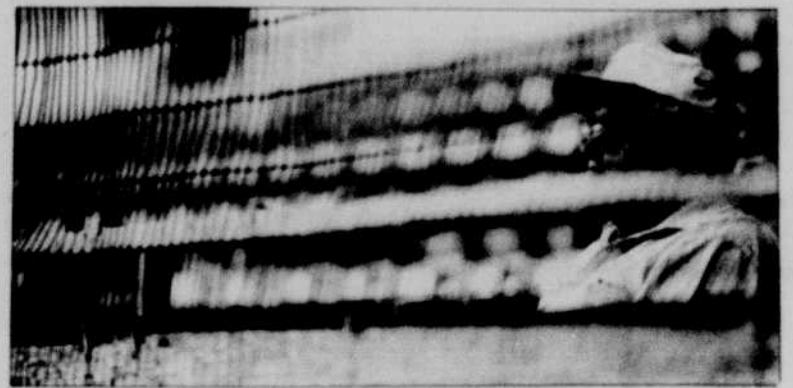

ment to adapt to. Players are sometimes thousands of miles from home, leaving behind family, friends, fiancées, and all that is familiar to spend the majority of their days in ballparks and on crowded, uncomfortable tour buses on the road to the next game.

For many players, it is the bus ride that proves the loneliest part of the game.

"I hate it," said Eugene first baseman Wilton Person. "It's so uncomfortable. It seems like you always have a crick in your neck. People do whatever they can to relax. Usually, every seat is taken, and it's kind of hard to recline in your seat, so people will sleep in the aisles."

"Sometimes it's impossible to sleep," Trippy said, "so you learn to play a lot of cards. It's fun though, having to worry about nothing but baseball."

But being happy isn't enough to realize the dream.

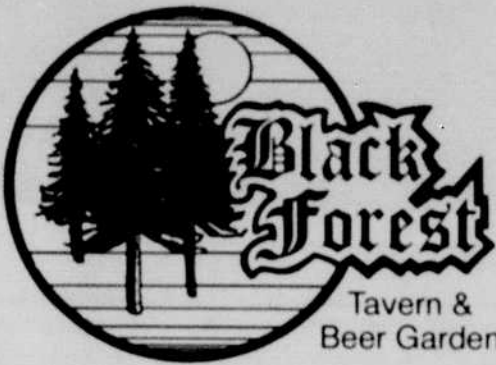
"If a player is just happy to be here," said Bellingham Giants pitching coach Ron Perranoski, "then that means he has already accomplished his goals. I wouldn't want a player like that on my team."

Ball players have to spend every day on the field — taking batting practice, shagging flies, fielding ground balls — trying to gain an edge over the next guy in an effort to be noticed by the front office and get called up to the next level.

The game is no longer just a game at this level, it is a business, and when the players, who are the product, don't produce results quick enough, the front office loses patience. This could mean a trip down to the instruc-

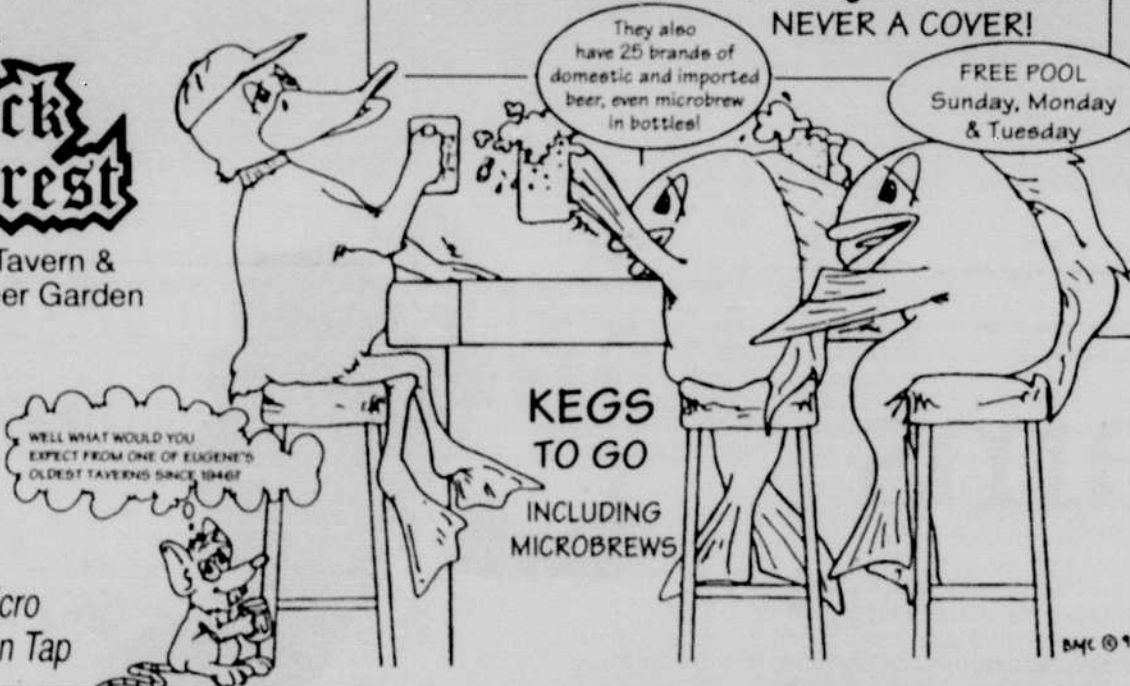
