- **DAVIS CUP**—Fined the Russian tennis federation \$25,000 for the court-watering incident in the Davis Cup semifinals against Germany.

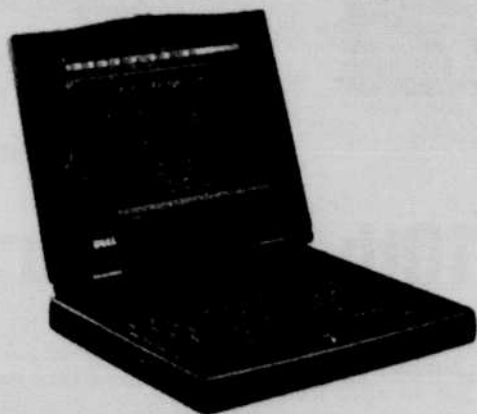

- **YALE**—Named Bruce Wolanin men's assistant ice hockey coach.



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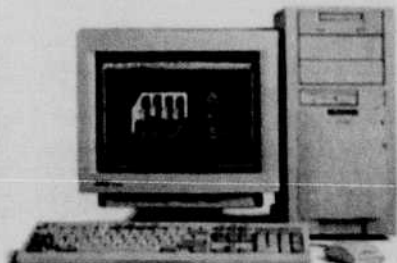


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
