USC defensive end asks judge for help

■ **TROJANS:** A suspended football player tries to get reinstated for game

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Defensive end Israel Ifeanyi, one of three Southern California players suspended by the Trojans last month because of alleged involvement with a sports agent, asked a judge Thursday to force the NCAA to allow him to play Saturday at Notre Dame.

The NCAA Enforcement Committee ruled Wednesday that Ifeanyi was subject to a four-game penalty.

Originally, USC was informed that Ifeanyi would be penalized for three games, but the penalty was extended when it was learned Ifeanyi accepted some money from his Nigerian tribesmen. The school contends that such gifts were a cultural custom.

The NCAA agreed to hear Ifeanyi's appeal of its decision Friday. But when the governing body announced the hearing would be delayed until next week, attorney Fred Wooster

went to Los Angeles Superior Court Judge Robert O'Brien.

The judge issued an order allowing Ifeanyi to accompany the team to South Bend, Ind. He also set an emergency hearing Friday morning to decide if Ifeanyi should be allowed to play against the Fighting Irish.

"We're hoping to prevail tomorrow, or reach an agreement with the NCAA," Wooster said.

In court papers, Wooster argued that the appeal hearing with the NCAA will be meaningless if Ifeanyi is barred from playing Saturday.

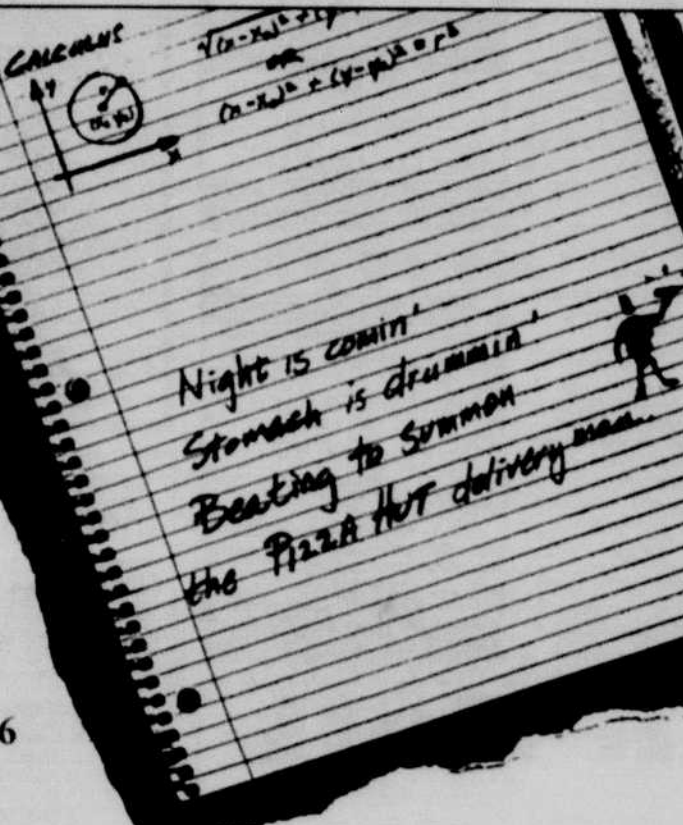
"The USC-Notre Dame is one of the most highly publicized regular season games in college football," the complaint states.

"Once a game is missed," Wooster added, "it is missed forever."

Ifeanyi and Trojan linebacker Erick Herrin and running back Shawn Walters were suspended Sept. 28 for allegedly accepting favors from sports agent Robert Caron, who was later sued by USC and has settled out of court.
