

Washington may play Oregon without its starting tailback

■ **FOOTBALL:** Senior Leon Neal's broken right foot may force Huskies to start injured Rashaan Shehee

SEATTLE (AP) — The No. 15 Washington Huskies may be missing tailback Leon Neal for their final three Pacific-10 Conference games. Neal is talking about having surgery soon to repair a broken bone in his right foot.

"I'm feeling real sore right now," Neal said Monday. "I can't put any pressure down on my foot."

Neal, named Pac-10 Offensive Player of the Week, was on crutches two days after rushing

31 times for a career-high 152 yards and two touchdowns in a 21-21 tie with No. 14 Southern California at Husky Stadium. He returned to the lineup after missing three games because of what initially was described by the Huskies as a sprained and dislocated big toe.

His foot was still badly swollen Monday after he re-injured it against the Trojans.

Coach Jim Lambright on Monday described Neal's injury as a stress fracture that will require surgery.

"It doesn't look good for Saturday at all unless a miracle happens," said Neal, who was originally injured Sept. 30 at

Oregon State.

Neal, a senior who was Napoleon Kaufman's backup last season, accounted for 291 all-purpose yards against USC with five receptions for 65 yards, two kickoff returns for 53 yards and four punt returns for 21 yards.

"If I injured my toe against Oregon State and I missed three games and it's injured again, then I most likely will miss three more games," Neal said. "So I might as well just go ahead and have the surgery and then be ready for our bowl game. That's what I'm thinking."

Washington starts this week tied with USC for the Pac-10 lead with a 4-0-1 record, but the

Trojans will go to the Rose Bowl instead of the Huskies because they have a better overall record (6-1-1 to 5-2-1) if both teams win their final three games.

The No. 2 Pac-10 team will go to the Cotton Bowl on New Year's Day.

The Huskies will start Rashaan Shehee at tailback against No. 19 Oregon Saturday in Seattle despite Shehee's torn ligaments in his left thumb, Lambright said.

Shehee will practice this week, but Lambright has instructed the other Huskies to stay clear of Shehee's tender thumb.

Shehee fell on his left thumb on a run in the first quarter

against the Trojans, making the Huskies use Neal more than they wanted to in the game. Shehee had 60 yards on seven carries.

Shehee leads Washington in rushing with 623 yards on 106 carries, a 5.9 average, and seven touchdowns this season. Neal has 539 yards on 100 carries, a 5.4 average, and three touchdowns.

With Neal's status unclear, Lambright said he may move starting fullback Richard Thomas in as Shehee's backup this week.

"Rashaan will be all right," Neal said. "He'll be able to play and play well."
