OREGON VS OREGON STATE

A Civil War to be remembered

Entering Civil War, everyone in the state of Oregon knew there was much more than just bragging rights on the line for the Ducks. A win in Corvallis would give the Ducks their first Rose Bowl berth in 37 years.

The Oregon State Beavers had no plans of letting the Ducks take the Pacific-10 Conference crown easily. Prior to the big game, Oregon State players — who were having another horrible season — were quoted as saying, "People in Eugene are going to have to wait a little longer to buy those tickets [to the Rose Bowl]."

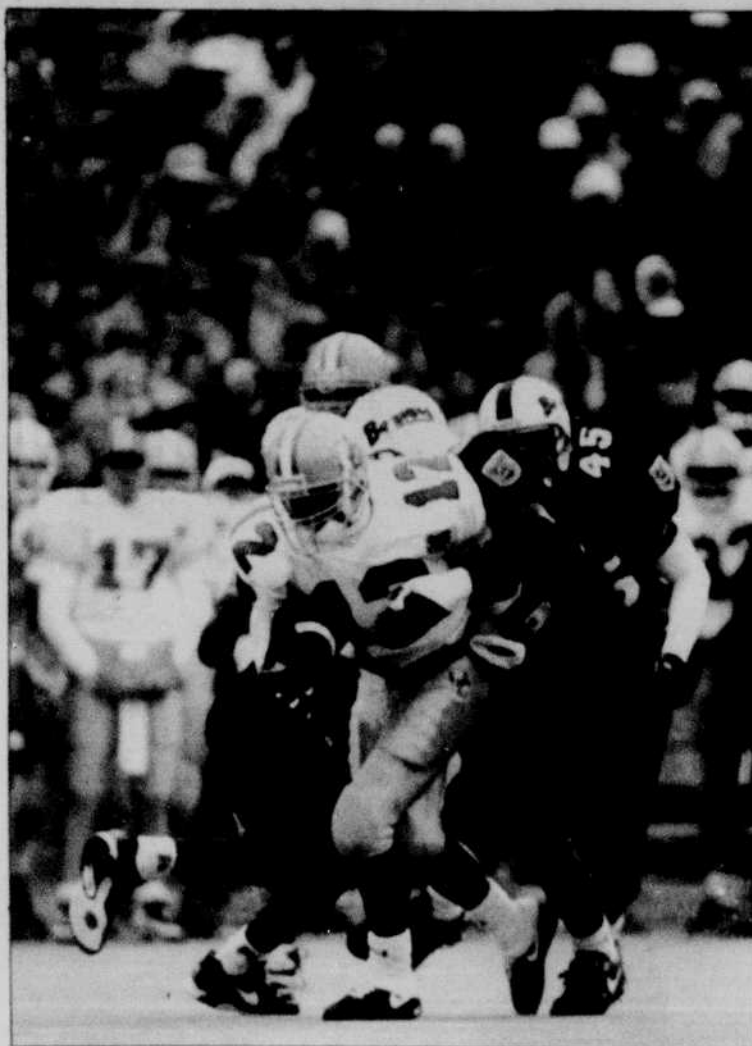
At 12:30 p.m. all of the talk stopped as the two teams went to war on bone-chilling 38-degree day, which included rain and 23 mph wind gusts. All the makings of another outstanding Civil War.

At the beginning, neither team was able to put a scoring drive together because of the wet conditions.

So the Ducks opted to go to the running game — and it worked. On seven consecutive plays the Ducks cut and slashed their way through the Beavers' defense. The Ducks had moved all the way down the field to the 18-yard line and were left with a third and four situation.

The "Quack Attack" went back to what it is known for best — the pass. Quarterback Danny O'Neil rolled out to his left and found tailback Dino Philyaw waiting in the flat for the short dump pass. Philyaw caught the ball and went in for a touchdown.

The Beavers' defense bounced back before the first half came to an end, notching Oregon State's first score of the game. The unit was able to force the Ducks to punt from deep inside their own end zone, giving the special teams squad a chance to go for a block. That's exactly what happened as Larry Bumpus got a piece of Matt Belden's punt and

Sylvester Green was able to fall on the ball in the end zone for the score.

The Ducks went into the locker room with a 10-7 lead following a Belden field goal.

In the second half, the Beavers' offense came alive putting together a 65-yard touchdown drive to grab a 13-10 lead. However, O'Neil and company were not going to let the Rose Bowl slip away.

With just under five minutes remaining, the Ducks started their victory drive at their own 30-yard line. The key play of the five-play, 70-yard drive, in

which O'Neil was four-of-five passing, was a post pattern to flanker Cristin McLemore for a 31-yard gain.

Once the offense got to the Beavers' 19-yard line, the call was for Philyaw. O'Neil rolled out to his left, much like the first touchdown pass, and hit Philyaw in the flat. He scampered the rest of the distance for the win.

"The screen pass to Philyaw was so well executed that it even brought a little bit of a smile to my face," Oregon head coach Rich Brooks said after the game.
