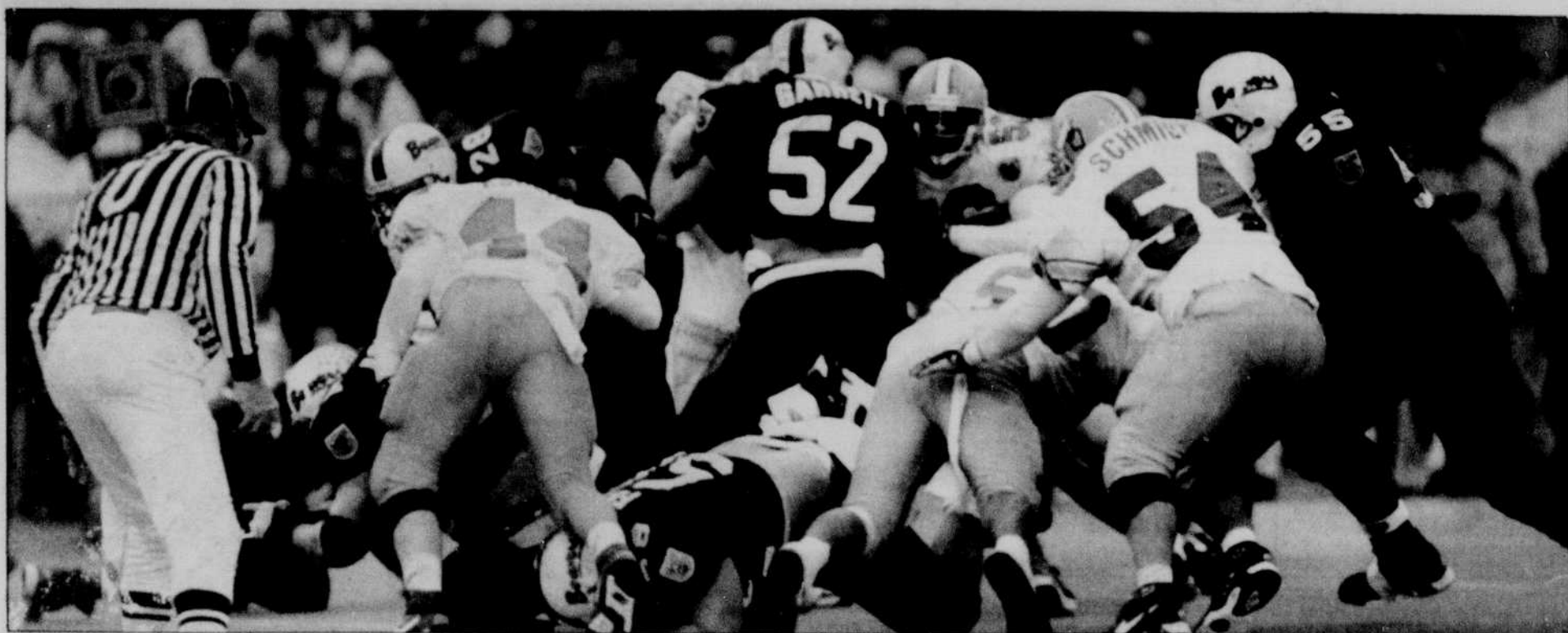

 their offense. Alexander did not play against Arizona and USC due to a separated shoulder and he will serve as Muhammad's back up this weekend.

Although many people may be looking past the Beavers, Bellotti isn't.

"I think from our standpoint, we have a lot riding on this game and obviously I think that Oregon State looks at this as a chance to salvage somewhat of a disappointing season for themselves," he said. "So I'm sure that they're going to pull out all the stops."

The game signifies Bellotti's first as a head coach in the Civil War.

"I understand the importance [of the game] to each of the players involved on both sides and to the state," he said. "I've talked about that this is for personal pride, institutional pride, team pride and finally state pride."

"And I think that obviously we have a tremendous amount riding on this game, but as I have

said all along, to me the focus needs to be on execution, not on emotion. We're going to play an emotional game, that's a given. I know that Oregon State's going to come out fired up and give it their best effort."

The Ducks came out of their win over Arizona last week with few injuries. Sophomore outside tackle David Weber injured his ankle and junior outside tackle Willy Rife has a knee injury, both suffered against the Wildcats. They are listed as probable. Red-shirt freshman tailback David Crump broke a bone in his wrist in Arizona, but will play in a cast. Bellotti is concerned with Crump's pain tolerance and how it will affect his ability to return kickoffs.

For twelve Oregon seniors, the game will be their last at Autzen Stadium. The offense will be losing tailback Ricky Whittle, flanker Cristin McLemore and outside guard Eric Reid. On defense, the Ducks will be losing nine members of Gang Green in

defensive tackle Troy Bailey; linebackers Paul Jensen, Rich Ruhl and Jeremy Asher; safeties Brian Collins and Dante Lewis; and cornerbacks Alex Molden, Issac Walker and Eugene Jackson. Bellotti gave these nine players credit for making 'Gang Green' a household phrase.

"Gang Green and all its fame it brought to the university and to our program is a function of those nine seniors on defense," Bellotti said. "Certainly that defense and those guys are Gang Green personified. They are the heart and soul of it."

The offense will lose some impact players in Whittle, McLemore and Reid, and Bellotti realizes the contributions that each made individually had a profound mark on the Oregon team.

"Their names are going to be on a lot of records and a lot of things," Bellotti said. "And more than that, what they've allowed
