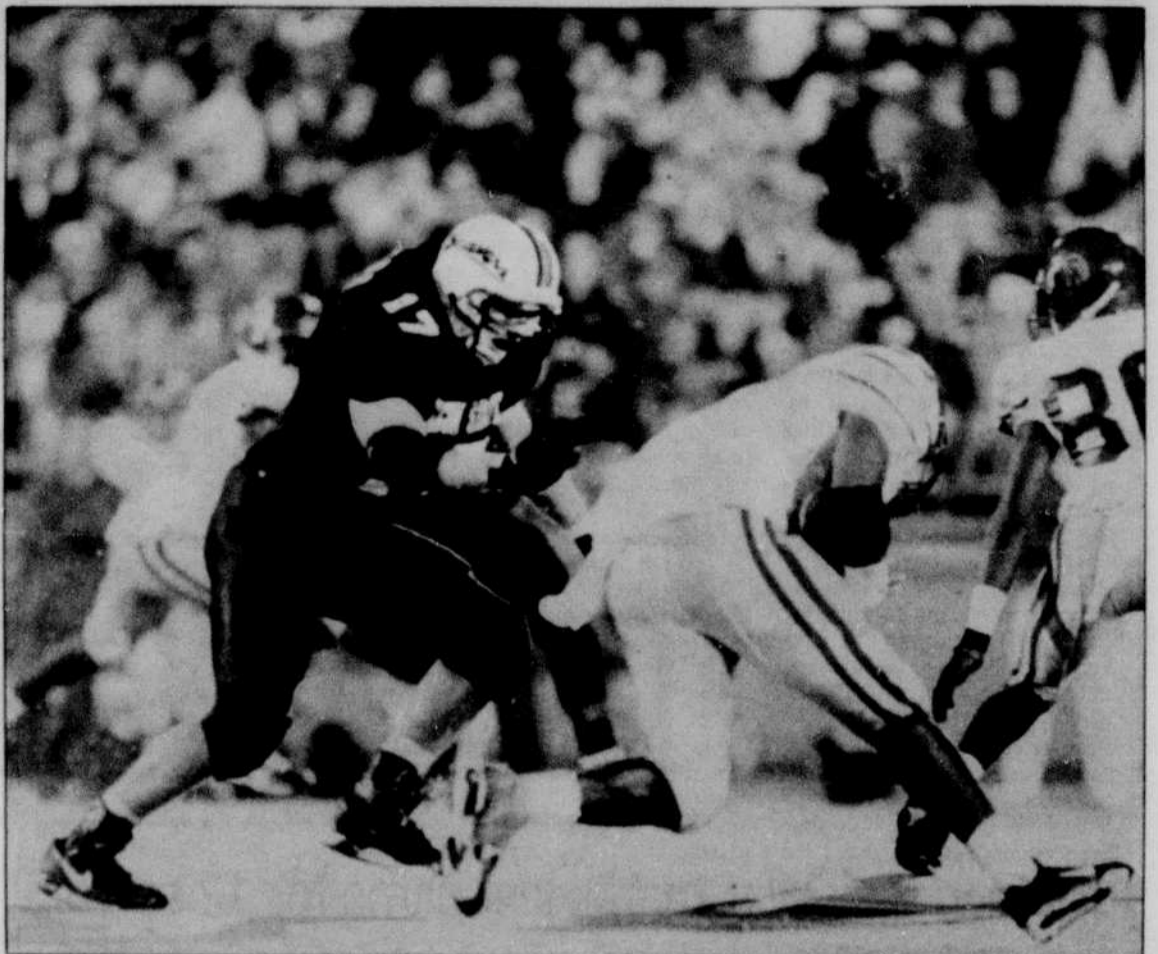

Beavers look for season-ending win

■ **OSU:** Despite a 1-9 record, Oregon State is always a dangerous team come Civil War time

Oregon State head football coach Jerry Pettibone has reached the end of his fifth year in not-so-glamorous fashion, as the Beavers enter the Civil War 1-9 after initially aspiring for their first winning season in 25 years.

The Beavers entered the season facing a favorable schedule and boasting a strong defense that had their fans and football experts alike thinking that Pettibone had finally put all the pieces of the program together.

"Our expectations were to have the first winning season in 25 years," Pettibone said, adding that the season's outcome has hit close to home. "We're very disappointed, but we continue to work hard."

Despite their record, the Beavers' defense has pulled its weight this season. It ranks second in total defense in the Pacific-10 Conference and is the No. 14 total defense in the nation. Oregon State is allowing 298.8 yards per game and 22.5 points per game.

Senior free safety Reggie Tongue has provided the Beavers with some consistency as he has started 38 straight games and is third in the Pac-10 with 110 tackles. In addition, the Beavers have

gotten significant help in their secondary as redshirt freshmen Andrae Holland and Armon Hatcher and sophomore strong safety Larry Bumpus have all picked off three passes this season.

The Beavers are fourth in the Pac-10 in sacks, as seniors Ahmani Johnson, Kane Rogers and Marc Williams all rank in the top ten in the conference in the category. Johnson is fifth with six sacks, while Rogers and Williams are tied for ninth with five apiece.

That defense has enabled Oregon State to stay competitive in several of its games.

"We've been right there all year," Pettibone said. "There
