Congress: Candidate focuses on state issues

Roberts met with members of the ASUO in October and had agreed to come to campus for a town hall meeting with students, although he has not been to campus since. He said he also talked with students on the PSU campus.

Some major issues for Roberts include balancing the budget in a way that does not hurt the economy, he said.

"Although I support a Balanced Budget Amendment, I do not favor a tax cut," he said.

Roberts also favors the block grant program, which would move the economic responsibilities back to the local level, he said. He plans to work on health care and is interested in the United States' role in the world and how much responsibility

the country is assuming.

As the former Lane County Commissioner, Roberts is familiar with the importance of the timber receipts and knows how the funds have decreased. He favors a more balanced approach to the timber dispute, which now tilts to environmental preservation. Oregon needs a long range plan that would allow the timber industry to rely on second growth trees and leave the old growth alone, he said. The timber riders in Congress and the protesters are indicators of the problem, he said.

Oregon also needs to get good paying jobs into the economy. The ones that are lost from the timber industry are not being replaced with jobs that provide for a family. Oregon lags behind the national average for per capita income, he said.
