Mullin said Green Hill sells gift certificates for the holidays that make excellent gifts. With a gift certificate, she said, people can come in and choose the animal they like, which will hopefully reduce the numbers of animals returned after the holidays.

"Often times people come in to choose animals for other people as gifts, and the right one isn't picked and winds up returned to us," Mullin said. "The people who want pets should come in and choose for themselves because it's not fair to the animals to be returned."

So this year, when putting together that holiday gift list, make your pets feel like a part of the family and buy them something special.

After all, a pet's happiness has no price tag.

"It's important to remember that animals are not for the holidays; they're for life," Mullin said.
