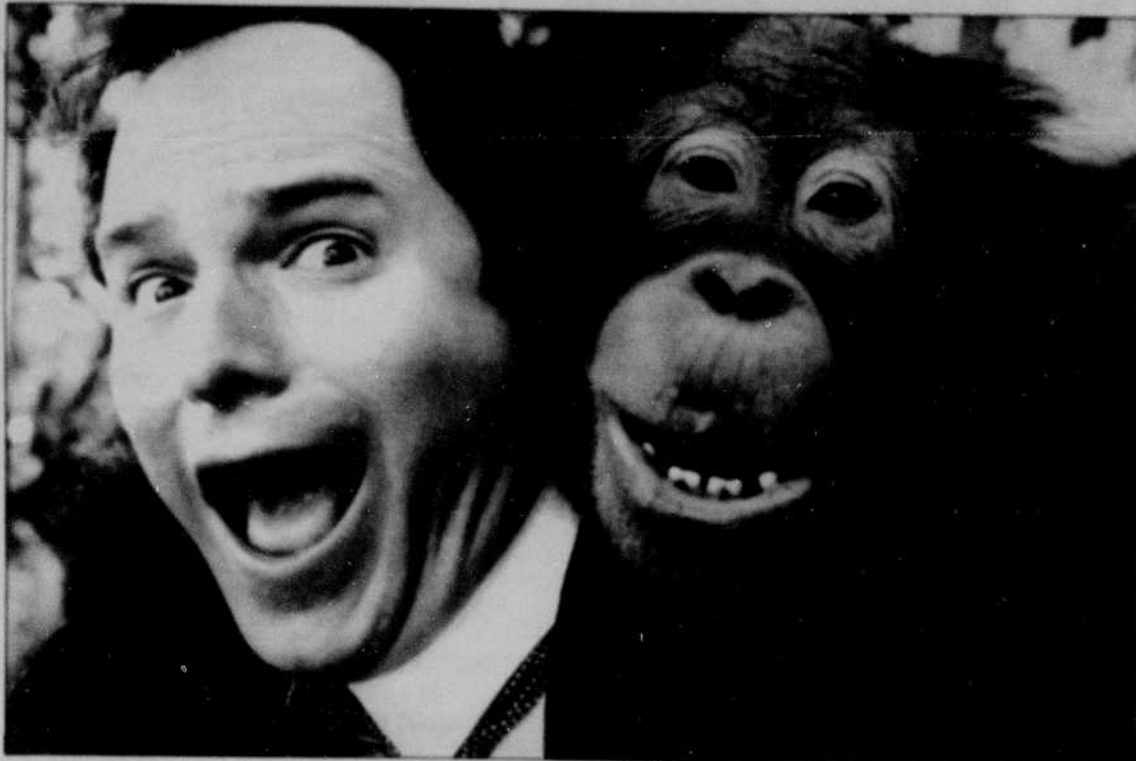

Animals lovers may enjoy 'Dunston'

The opening of Twentieth Century Fox's production of *Dunston Checks In* brings an adorable, 5-year-old orangutan to movie screens nationwide who is sure to win the hearts of audience members.

Dunston has long orange hair, climbs from limb and won over the cast's heart in his debut film. He was born in captivity and is not yet full grown. At the height of his maturity, Dunston will weigh more than 200 pounds.

The film, *Dunston Checks In*, tells the story of a high-class hotel manager who believes he's capable of handling anything until he encounters Dunston.

Dunston is the captive partner of a low-life jewelry thief, and his antics turn the five-star hotel into a three-ring circus.

The manager's young son,

Kyle, played by Eric Lloyd, rescues Dunston from his evil captor and then attempts to control Dunston's outrageous behavior.

The movie is a comic, fantasy adventure about life in a grand hotel and how things go from normal to a completely chaotic nightmare, particularly for manager Robert Grant.

The movie was filmed entirely in the Bullock's Wilshire building in Los Angeles. The historic department was converted, inside and out, into an art deco New York Hotel.

The film crew was the last movie company to shoot in the building before it was taken over by the Southwest University Law School which is committed to preserving its historical value.
