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Super Bowl brings out the stars

■ **SUPER BOWL:** Celebrities have gathered in Tempe in anticipation of the game

PHOENIX (AP) — Whether they prefer noisy nightspots in swanky Scottsdale or hushed hideouts in the desert mountains, celebrities such as Spike Lee and Magic Johnson are rolling into Arizona like tumbleweeds as Super Bowl Sunday approaches.

Celebrity-watching is turning into a sport of its own in the Valley of the Sun, luring residents to stakeouts at bars during unseasonably nippy nights and lobby lounging by day at the players' hotels.

"A lot of restaurants are going to see a pretty steady celebrity clientele from [Thursday] on," said Steve Tripp, society columnist for a newspaper in suburban Phoenix. "The weekend's going to be bonkers."

While stars like Kevin Costner, in town for a golf tournament, and David Spade, of *Saturday Night Live*, kept a low profile,

others headed straight for the limelight.

Well-publicized events included Johnson's kickoff party Wednesday night at Jetz Intercoastal Grill & Stixx, a trendy Scottsdale club, which was open to the public for \$20.

"Charles Barkley said this was going to be the best Super Bowl party," Tripp quoted the Phoenix Suns star as saying of Johnson's fiesta.

Fighter Mike Tyson and musical divas Salt n' Pepa and Queen Latifah were on the publicized guest list for a benefit tonight at the Wrigley Mansion. Filmmaker Lee was also in town for the game and scheduled to attend the party.

The invitation-only event also was expected to draw supermodel Veronica Webb, MTV's "Downtown" Julie Brown, L.L. Cool J, rapper Dr. Dre and Dallas Cowboys superstar Deion Sanders — whose name appeared to be on every guest list.

Some celebrities are only rumored to be in town, falsely

spotted by the media or promoted as possible attractions by their agents, said Planet Hollywood spokeswoman Jeannie Berg.

"People say Arnold Schwarzenegger and Bruce Willis are coming, and as far as I know they're not coming," Berg said of the stars who co-own the popular Scottsdale restaurant.

Michelle Phillips, one-time member of the Mamas and the Papas rock group, was spotted at an NFL "Players Party" at Planet Hollywood. She is in town filming a television movie with Fred Savage.

"I think that Phoenix is definitely growing, star-wise. Over the past couple years the popularity has boomed here, with people who are burnt out on California," said Dolores Tropiano, an entertainment columnist with *The Arizona Republic*.

Arizona is home to actress Sean Young and television journalist Hugh Downs, among others.

"The whole area is really hot," she said.

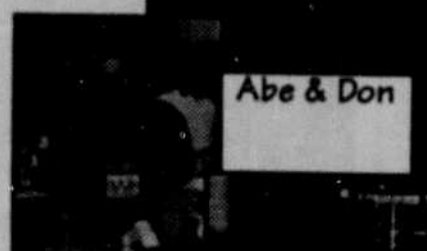
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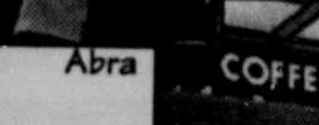
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
