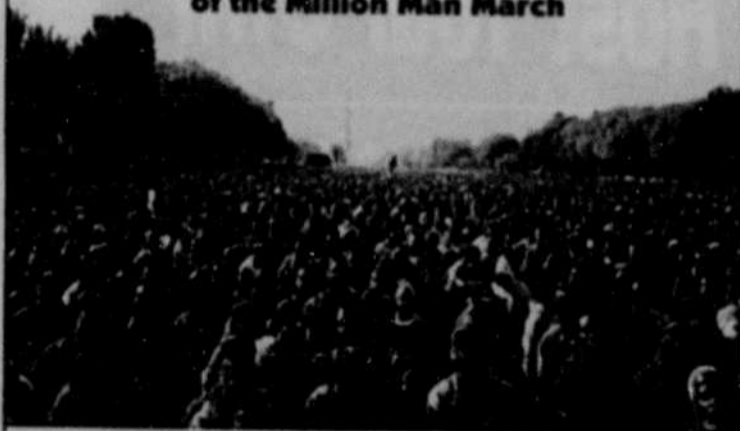

**PFC: Chairwoman says 'We're broke'**

"The increases we got were fair," said Carichoff. "They were justified."

KWVA, the campus radio station, requested a total budget of \$104,546, or an increase of more than 100 percent. However, committee members said the PFC cannot afford that much of an increase.

"We don't have any money to give this increase," said Skye Brigner, PFC co-chairwoman. "We're broke basically."

"I think it's pretty obvious that you're not going to get this as requested," added the other PFC co-chairwoman, Susan Anderson. The PFC decided to fund the station at \$56,182, representing a more modest 8.47 percent increase.

The committee cut money from KWVA's stipend request, although stipends had only been "barely enough to cover parking tickets," according to J. Pierson, current general manager of

KWVA. However, the committee allowed a dramatic increase in the future general manager's salary.

"Switching this position over to a general manager [from a stipend-paid job] is critical," Anderson said.

Pierson agreed with this decision, saying the position is "saddled with a lot of responsibility" and cannot be taught "in three months at a seminar."

The PFC also chose to deny

funding for the radio station's promotions, fearing some promotional items could be used for fundraising, an inappropriate use of student funds.

KWVA had requested funds for a satellite dish to "download multicultural programming," according to Christina Hebert, KWVA assistant general manager. The PFC denied this request, although the committee urged the station to put the request before student voters this spring.
