

Super Bowl MVP is now a Raider

■ **NFL:** Larry Brown felt the squeeze in Dallas with Deion Sanders and Kevin Smith returning next year

OAKLAND, Calif. (AP) — Cornerback Larry Brown, whose worth on the free-agent market soared after being voted the Super Bowl's most valuable player, is leaving the Dallas Cowboys for the Oakland Raiders.

Brown, who had two interceptions in the Cowboys' 27-17 victory over the Pittsburgh Steelers, would not disclose details of the contract, except to say it was for

more than one year.

"There's a point in your life when you have to realize it's time to move on. I think I came to that page," Brown said Tuesday at a news conference.

The Cowboys were not expected to re-sign Brown because of salary-cap restrictions and the available cornerback combination of Deion Sanders and Kevin Smith.

Sanders, who has juggled football and baseball, was planning to concentrate exclusively on the Cowboys next season. And Smith, who was sidelined for all but the Cowboys' 1995 season opener with an Achilles' tendon

injury, was expected to return.

That left Brown open to offers. Brown would not say whether Dallas offered as much as the Raiders ultimately did.

"I wanted to get it behind me," he said. "It wasn't all about money."

Brown, 26, played a lot last season, finishing with six interceptions, including two for touchdowns.

Brown first attracted attention in 1991 when he went from 12th-round draft pick out of Texas Christian to start. He went on to start on Super Bowl-winning teams over the next two years.
