Graduate student to present 'Nine Narratives'

Graduate student Catherine Roach will present her dance thesis concert March 2

Catherine Roach, in collaboration with eight local dancers, will present the premiere of "Nine Narratives," a master's degree thesis concert featuring five different dances.

"Nine Narratives" values women expressing their own stories," said Roach, a GTF in the department of dance and a member of Rose Hips Dance Company.

With "Nine Narratives," Roach investigates an interrelation between collaboration and personal narrative throughout the dance-making process.

"The narratives are actual stories the dancers told in interviews," she said. According to Roach, throughout the rehearsal process the nine dancers discovered techniques for telling stories through movement and text.

"Nine Narratives" features two solo performances, one by Roach and the other by Meta Bruner. Also included in the show are a duet performed by Amy Dore and Carrie Nelson, and a trio performed by Kristin Hapke, Emily Stromquist and Melinda Teutschel.

A group piece toward the end of the performance will include all of the dancers as well as Nicole Woodard and Linda Ulvaeus.

"Nine Narratives" will premiere at 8 p.m. March 2 with a repeat performance at 2 p.m. March 3 in the Dougherty Theatre at Gerlinger Annex. Admission is free.
