

# Siege: Police use 'flash-bang' device trying to force Davis out

him out of where he was hiding."

The device was placed on a long metal pole that police suspended over Davis' hiding place. "The flash-bang device creates a loud boom, and it has a big concussion," Terrett said. "That device is used often on entries, high-risk entries such as this."

Police used the flash-bang device twice in an attempt to get Davis to come out of the attic. After the device was used unsuccessfully for the second time, a police officer went into the attic with a dog.

"As the dog was searching for [Davis], the officer spotted him and immediately grabbed him," Terrett said.

Police took him from the attic and moved him into the house at 3 p.m. While searching the house, SWAT team members discovered a methamphetamine lab in the garage.

Fehrle was taken into custody Tuesday morning after she willingly left the house.

Neighbors said they had suspected there was drug activity in the house for a few weeks but

were shocked to see a standoff in their neighborhood.

The Interagency Narcotics Enforcement Team from the Eugene Police Department obtained a search warrant for the house, located at 965 E. 42nd Ave.

Prior to Tuesday, the Interagency Narcotics Enforcement Team raided four methamphetamine labs or partial labs in the last six months.

SWAT team member Derel V. Schulz, 28, was injured when his weapon, an HKMP5, accidentally went off and shot his right foot. He was taken to Sacred Heart Medical Center, where he underwent surgery.
