■ Kappa Alpha Theta is sponsoring an Easter egg hunt for the Jasper Mountain Center on Saturday at 11 a.m. The Jasper Mountain Center is a home for young children who have been removed from their home because of an abusive situation. Children will hunt eggs and play games during the event.

■ Lively Park Swim Center at 6100 Thurston Rd. in Springfield is hosting Easter egg hunts for children of all ages on Saturday. The cost is \$2 per child and participants will have an opportunity to have a picture taken with the Easter Bunny. There will also be a rabbit petting corral and face painting.

The toddler Easter egg hunt will take place from 10 a.m. to noon. At 10:30 a.m. preschoolers will have an egg hunt and parents are allowed to help. At 11 a.m. kindergarten to first grade groups will hunt eggs, but parents are not allowed to help. Second through third grades will hunt eggs at 11:30 a.m. Then at 11:45 a.m. there will be a dedication for Willamalane's new stage.

Little Caesar's Pizza will be giving out free drinks from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. Pizza will be sold for \$1.50 per slice. There will be entertainment for children on stage from noon to 1 p.m.

■ The first annual Runaway Egg Hunt will start at 10 a.m. with registration commencing at 9 a.m. on Saturday at the Saturday Market, 35 E. 8th Ave. The egg hunt is hosted by Fenton & Lee Confections.

Children aged 2-8 years old can participate. There is no admission charge; however, children need to register at the East lawn of Saturday Market. There will be three different age groups. Every child will receive free chocolate. Other prizes include children's books, hats, Taco Time coupons and grand prizes of \$50 savings bonds. Following the activities, Sharon Rodgers, a children's folk musician, will entertain.

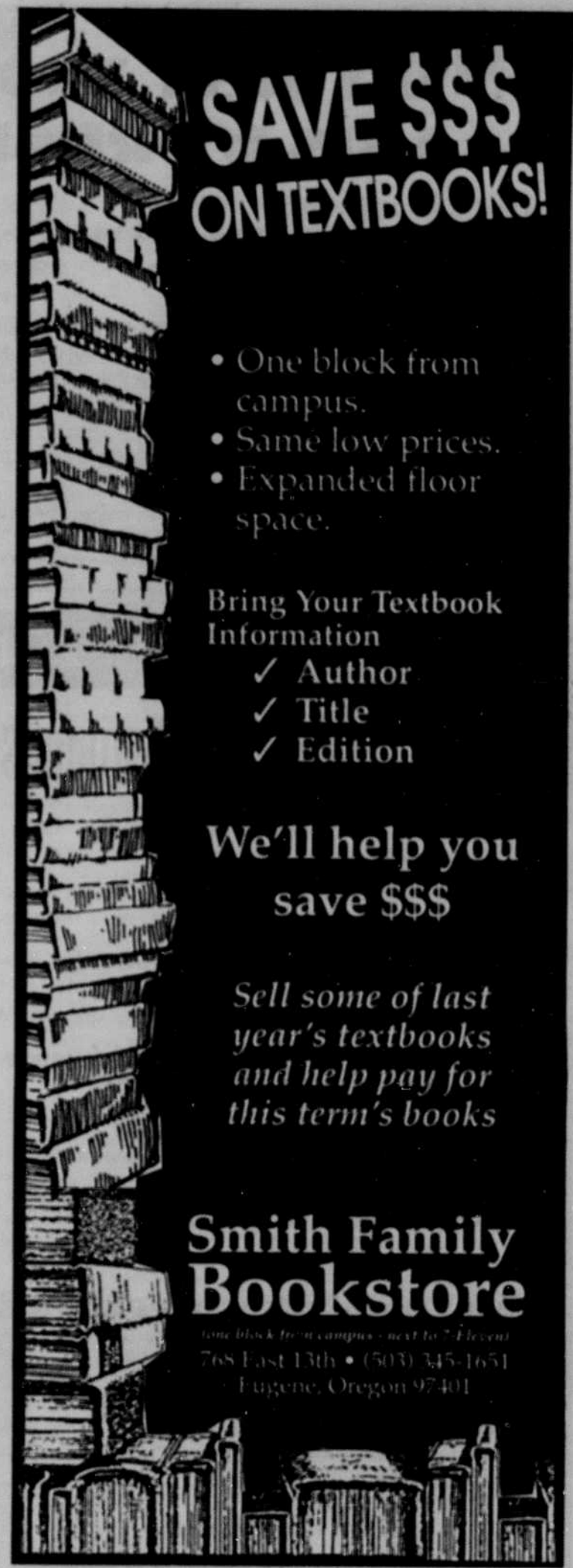
