Dinner: Event funds hunger relief

 Portland Brewing Company and The Wild Duck.
 Chef's Night Out is part of a national program called "Taste of the Nation," which organizes similar events all across the country. It is sponsored by Share Our Strength, an anti-hunger organization that furnishes grants to groups all over the world that distribute food and treat the consequences of malnutrition.
 "We have corporate underwriters, so 100 percent of our ticket sales go to hunger relief," Crumbley said.
 In addition, all the food, beverages, time and effort provided by the participants are donated.
 Last year, Eugene's event raised \$16,000 for hunger relief. This year's event topped that,

bringing in approximately \$20,000.
 Seventy percent of those funds stay in Lane County, going to Food for Lane County, which provides emergency food services through 65 agencies in the area. Twenty percent goes to Share Our Strength, which use it to fund its international work, and the remaining 10 percent to a food bank in Klamath Falls.
 Guests had the chance to dine on delicacies such as the smoked salmon and smoked beef tenderloin with chutneys prepared by Chef Michael Thieme from Sweetwaters, who has participated in Chef's Night Out for the past four years.
 Chefs and other members of the food service industry had an opportunity to meet each other and present their creations in a unique venue.
