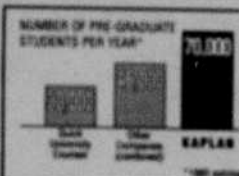

the weekend as Oregon won the women's 3,200-meter relay, the men's 6,400-meter relay and junior Chris Nelson won the men's high jump competition.

The Ducks' success began on Friday, as Oregon reclaimed its title in the men's 6,400-meter relay. The team of seniors Karl Keska and Rick Cantwell, junior Daniel Das Neves and sophomore Greg James beat out the competition by .11 seconds. Oregon lost the event last year with a less than healthy team but thanks to Keska's unofficial 4-minute, 7.7 second anchor leg, the Ducks were able to avenge last year's defeat.

The women also had a strong

showing on Friday as senior Niamh Zwagerman finished fourth in the 10,000-meter run, and the distance medley relay team finished second behind Arizona with a time of 11:29.27.

On Saturday, Oregon got the ball rolling with Nelson's win in the high jump. Nelson bettered his NCAA provisional qualifying standing at Drake with a jump of 7-3. Nelson, who holds the Ducks' school record with a jump of 7-4 1/2, also improved on his personal outdoor best of 7-2 1/2, which he set earlier in the season at Arizona.

The women later followed Nelson's win with a victory in the 3,200 relay, as the team of freshman Sue Morris, sophomore

Kaarin Knudson, freshman Marie Davis and junior Vicky Fleschner won the event by more than seven seconds over second place Texas-Arlington.

Oregon's winning mark of 8:44.36 was the fastest time in the event at the Drake Relays in the last three years.

The women's other strong showing came in the 1,600-meter relay as seniors LaReina Woods and Jamila Godfrey, Morris and junior Nicole Commissiong finished fourth with a time of 3:41.82.

Sophomore Gregg Bleakney also came up big for the Ducks on Saturday, finishing third in the triple jump competition with a wind-aided leap of 51-0.

Jordan injures back in win over Miami

CHICAGO (AP) — Michael Jordan walked in pain to the Chicago Bulls locker room just before halftime Sunday after straining his lower back on a drive against the Miami Heat.

Jordan received treatment at the half and then returned for the second half and hit his first shot, although he still he appeared to be running gingerly.

"He strained his back when he went up for that shot, strained a muscle on the right side," said Dr. John Hefferon, team physician. "He was hurting, but he's done this before

and he's always been able to play with it."

Jordan went on for a reverse layup around Tyrone Corbin and Chris Gatling and then came down in an awkward position with 2:39 remaining in the first half.

Grimacing at the free-throw line, Jordan stayed in the game and made two free throws, giving him 26 points as the Bulls built a 63-38 lead.

Wheaton injured in Saturday scrimmage
