Meetings to focus on W. Alton Baker Park

A series of public meetings on updating the development plan for the west portion of Alton Baker Park will begin tonight at 7:30 at the Celeste Campbell Senior Center, 155 High St.

At the meeting, city staff will seek comments from community residents and organizations about the location, character and scale of activities and improvements in West Alton Baker Park. At subsequent meetings the design program, followed by the plan itself, will be shared and revised according to public comments received.

Eugene may eliminate \$1.50 recycle rebate

The city of Eugene is proposing to eliminate the \$1.50 rebate Eugene residents now receive for placing recyclables at their home curbsides for pickup along with their garbage.

The city has set rates and standards for curbside collection. Rates are based on the average weight of each container, with larger containers being charged equal or higher rates per pound. The city will accept public

input until 5 p.m. June 7. The rebate would end July 1. To receive a copy of the administrative order and a fact sheet about solid waste and recycling rates, call 465-2744. Three-month project delays traffic on 11th

Work is scheduled to begin today on a three-month project to rehabilitate East 11th Avenue between Franklin Boulevard and Pearl Street.

The city of Eugene project includes replacing and upgrading portions of the waste water collection system, rebuilding sections of the roadway and putting a new surface on the entire street.

The work will be done by Wildish Construction Co.

Motorists are advised to use alternate routes to avoid traffic delays and detours in the project area. To reduce traffic in construction zones, one of the two turn lanes from Franklin Boulevard onto East 11th Avenue will be closed throughout the project.

On East 11th, the contractor will keep two westbound traffic lanes open from 7 to 10 a.m. After 10 a.m., only one westbound lane will be open in active construction zones, and at times portions of the street may be closed to traffic.

Homes and businesses along East 11th Avenue will remain accessible during construction, and sidewalks will remain open. The project is scheduled to be completed by August 30. For current information about Lane Transit District routes, call 687-5555.
