Senator Kalpana Krishnamurthy said a letter from the Senate was important in addressing the concerns of University students.

"This is coming from students at the University who feel this message is personally attacking them," she said. "We need to recognize that."

In other business, a representative from the Designated Driver Shuttle presented the group's goal statement. The original wording of the statement was disputed, and the Senate postponed discussion until the wording was rectified.

"I'm concerned it doesn't concern all the stuff you do," Krishnamurthy said. "It's very limited

in what it talks about doing. It's really vague."

Later in the proceedings, DDS Director Thomas McCarthy resubmitted the statement with changes in the content to include specific reference to education of alcohol-related effects.

The Senate also approved two special requests. The *Commentator* requested a line-item transfer of \$445 to go toward telephone, postage and office supply line items.

The Senate also approved its own line item-transfer special request. A total of \$227 will be moved into the office supplies account in order to purchase computer printer toner, paper, cassette tapes and paint for the office.

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
