## Female pitcher throws one inning, gets the win

BASEBALL: Pamela Davis got a standing ovation from the crowd

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. (AP) — At first, the Jacksonville Suns offered Pamela Davis a courtesy handshake and idle chatter. When she was done, they were slapping her on the back and telling her to take a curtain call.

Davis may not have proved she was ready for minor league baseball, let alone the majors. But for one inning in an exhibition against the Australian Olympic team, she proved she was good enough to try.

"I think I proved women can pitch," she said after her one inning of scoreless relief in the Suns' 7-2 victory Tuesday night. "I felt really good out there."

Now, the 21-year-old starter with the Colorado Silver Bullets women's baseball team hopes more women will get a chance like hers.

"I hope it will go somewhere," she said. "The Colorado Silver Bullets gave me a chance to play pro baseball; gave me a chance to be where I am now. I don't know

what doors are going to open for women in baseball. Hopefully, some will."

She wanted only to send a message to young girls that it's all right to chase their dreams of playing pro baseball. She left with a memorable night that included a strikeout, a standing ovation — and the win.

Davis is believed to be the first woman to pitch for a major league farm club under the current structure of minor league baseball. In an agreement between the Southern League and the Silver Bullets, she was added to the Suns' roster for the exhibition game.

Davis entered in the fifth with a fastball that didn't get much past 70 mph, but good location and pitch selection kept the shutout intact.

"It had to be a bit rough after facing 90 mph cheese and then trying to hit 60 mph," said Australian center fielder Grant MacDonald.

Davis threw 18 pitches, 10 of them for strikes. She gave up a leadoff double to Peter Vogler, retired two batters on ground outs to second and sent the crowd of 1,517 to their feet by striking out Michael Dunn.
