

Got Dogs? Be a responsible tenant

Tenants who face pet policy changes or are sure they will never find rental housing that will accept their pets are a major source of dogs that are given up for adoption to humane organizations or destroyed at animal control centers.

Here are some tips on how to protect your rights as a pet owner. Do a walk-through with your landlord before you move in. Note or photograph any current dam-

ages. This information should be in writing and signed by both of you. Get a provision in your lease permitting your dog.

Introduce your dog to the new home gradually, before you move in. Take time to deal with their stress as well as yours.

Get to know your neighbors and have them meet your dog. Teach your dog not to bark at them or keep the dog inside if they cannot be trusted. Clean up after your dog, supervise him, and do not let him roam unleashed.

Train your dog. Housebreaking problems and destroyed carpets are the two complaints most cited by landlords who stopped renting to tenants with dogs.

Make sure you keep your

house as clean as possible at all times. Wash down the walls now and again. Good housekeeping may not be your forte, but surprise inspections by wary landlords do happen. Try to be prepared. Your responsible behavior may keep rental possibilities open for other dog lovers.

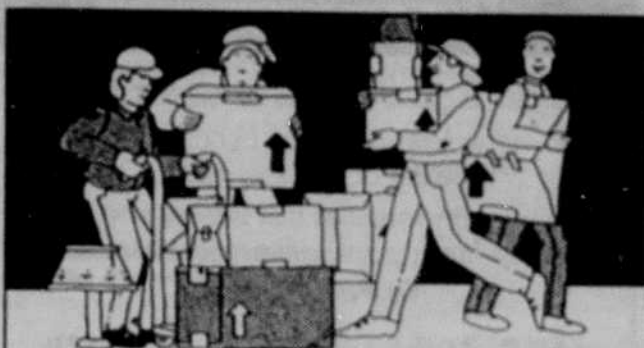

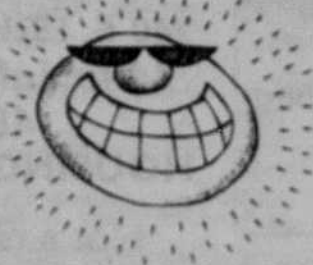
