Each house has their own room and board obligations. Specific costs are available during IFC and PFC rush. Most sororities require the chapter to be full before releasing members from their housing obligations. Most fraternities require a minimum eight term housing commitment. 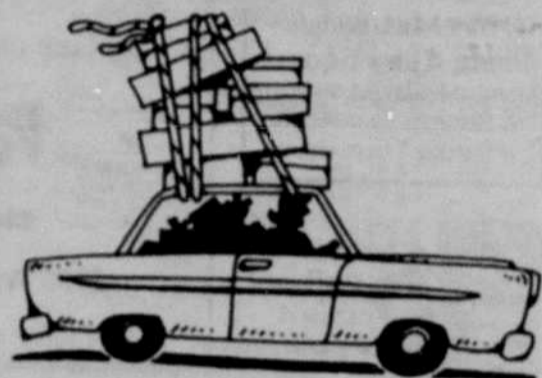
